
Dear Milwaukee City Clerk, City Attorney Spencer, and Investigator Klosiewski:

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Melby-Gibbons:

We have received your claim for the amount of \$1,600.00 in relation to the damage to your fence that occurred on June 29, 2022, at your residence at 2339 North Sherman Boulevard.

Our investigation determined the Milwaukee Police Department(MPD) was engaged in a high speed chase involving a stolen vehicle on June 29, 2022. The stolen vehicle came to a stop in the area of 2305 North Sherman Boulevard. Three suspects exited the vehicle and began to flee on foot, running through the alley and back yards in the area. MPD officers continued the pursuit on foot, and in the process your fence was damaged. All three suspects were subsequently apprehended and taken into custody.

It is our position that the police department acted within the scope of their responsibility, and the action taken in this matter was appropriate and necessary for the circumstances in this case. As such, the City of Milwaukee would not be liable and we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
