There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the
above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

Witkowski, Michael J 031445

This report is being written by P.O. Michael WITKOWSKI, assigned to District 3, Day Shift, and Squad 3131.

During a business check at 8:21 a.m., P.O. KOWALIK and I were in the parking lot of Family Dollar, 2214 N 35th St., located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

While parked outside of Family Dollar watching the business we noticed one male subject who was later identified as Jonathan JONES, (m/b, 3/21/80), enter the business. Approximately five minutes later we noticed JONES running out of the business when store employees were running behind him saying that he was stealing and we could hear them saying he was stealing due to our squad windows being rolled down. The employees were telling us that he was wearing all black clothing and he ran westbound down the alley towards 36th St.

P.O. KOWALIK and I then left the parking lot in our squad car to follow JONES who was on foot heading westbound through the alley towards the 3600 block of N 36th St., when we approached the JONES at the location of 3601 W North Av., we saw that JONES had a black bag in his hand with merchandise from Family Dollar that still had security locks on it.

JONES was then placed into custody for matching the description that was provided by the store employees and having a bag of merchandise from Family Dollar.

JONES was conveyed to District 3 at 8:40 a.m., for booking by Squad 3130, P.O. Frank YINKO.

After JONES was conveyed, P.O. KOWALIK and I went back to Family Dollar to talk to the employees of the incident. Danyelle G CRAWLEY, (f/b, 8/25/87), stated that she noticed JONES walked into the business and that he looked suspicious to her because he was quiet and didn't say a word to anyone in the store. CRAWLEY said that she saw JONES then putting what seemed to be merchandise into a black bag in one of the aisles. She then said that JONES left the aisle and then ran out of the front doors of the business past the last point sale. CRAWLEY showed me the video regarding the incident and you could clearly see JONES inside of the business putting merchandise from the shelves into a bag and then leaving the business past the last point of sale without paying.

I also spoke with employee Precious K BANKS, (f/b, 10/21/85), who stated that she saw JONES walk in and then when she was at the front counter she saw him moving towards the front doors. She said that she noticed he was stealing something because the merchandise he had in the bag had security tags on it and he activated the alarm sensors. BANKS said she then followed JONES out of the store and started yelling that he was stealing.

A PV-17 and Community Contact Card were issued to the store employees.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/29/2022 at 1:25 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
