Program Goal: The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to local governments. The FY2022 JAG is awarded to the City of Milwaukee who will serve as the fiscal agent on behalf of the City of West Allis and Milwaukee County. The City's allocation of \$522,034 of the total \$955,716 award (\$21,501 allocated to City of West Allis and \$412,181 allocated to Milwaukee County) will fund the Milwaukee Community Justice Council Director; MPD facilities improvements at the Milwaukee Training Academy for training room floor replacement, and energy efficiency exterior lighting upgrades at police district stations; IT equipment including computer and project for the Training Academy and MPD Microsoft server upgrade; red dot sight scopes; and 3 patrol vehicles.
