Property 1550 N Prospect Ave Goll House

**Proposal** The current proposal before the commission is to approve the relocation of the Goll House

on its same lot to accommodate new high rise construction to the rear of the property. The

Goll House will not be connected to the new development.

**Staff comments** The Goll House has been locally designated since December 11, 2002. It has been a

contributing building to the Prospect Avenues Mansions National Register Historic District

since April 7, 1990.

Highly similar projects have come before this body in the past and have been approved. The approvals have expired and the owners, applicants, and designs have changed enough to

require review de novo.

The proposed relocation of the Goll House will move the structure to the northwest approximately 36'-11" from its current location, giving it a similar setback to the adjacent structures on Prospect Avenue. The entry terrace will be retained and moved in conjunction with the rest of the structure. A comparative setback analysis has been provided and demonstrates the new general alignment of building frontages. Further there is no evidence that the front yard of this property ever had landscaping of any historical or aesthetic

significance.

The new construction is not subject to our review.

**Recommendation** Recommend HPC Approval. The house will be preserved on its original site and the city will

retain one of its significant heritage houses, designed by one of the top architectural firms, Ferry and Clas. Prospect Avenue will retain some of the significance it had when it was known as the showplace of the city while making room for new high-density housing. The mansion will still have context and visibility and relate to the other mansions in the National

Register historic district.
