I just wanted to send in my concerns for the renewal of Mangos Cafe license. As a neighbor of this establishment, I have witnessed a major increase in crime since the opening of this restaurant. Patrons of this bar continue to throw trash into my yard, yell and argue, fight, blast loud music, and shoot guns around my property (10 shots fired in front of my house caught on camera 11/24). This has been an ongoing problem since the restaurant opened. There aren't any problems with any of the other bars around the area, but this one in particular is catering to the wrong group of people, and the owners have not been taking any responsibility for these issues. All of the neighbors on this block of Van Buren have been expressing the same concerns since the opening of this establishment, and I do not support the continuation of this business or the renewal of their license.

- 9. On 05/15/2017 officers were dispatched to a shots fired complaint at 1638 N. Van Buren St. The investigation revealed the subject involved had been inside Mango's, 1682 N. Van Buren St. He exited and was denied re-entry by security. As he was walking away he pulled out a gun and fired shots into the air. The tavern does not have working video surveillance system and had no ID scanner.

11. On 04/17/2018 at 1:41am officers were dispatched to Mango's Café East, 1682 N. Van Buren St, for a Noise Nuisance complaint. The officer attempted to contact the caller but received no answer. On 04/17/2018 at 1:00pm an officer contacted the caller who stated there were two groups of people that left Mango's and were yelling very loudly at each other and began playing loud music. No employees of Mango's were observed outside to help manage the crowd. The officer cited the agent for Excessive Noise.

12.On 11/29/2018 an underage compliance check was conducted at Mango's, 1682 N. Van Buren St. Mango's passed the compliance check.

- 13. On 03/26/2019 at 1:00am officers were flagged down by security at Mango's Bar for a disorderly subject that security had removed from the bar. The subject was issued a Disorderly Conduct citation. While on scene security again flagged the officers down for subjects removed for fighting inside. One of the subjects was issued an Assault and Battery citation.
- 14. On 04/16/2019 at 1:27am officers were dispatched to 1682 N. Van Buren St for a battery complaint. The officers spoke with security who stated an altercation occurred between two females sitting at the bar. Security broke up the fight and escorted one of the subjects out. The officers spoke with the owner, Greg KIECKBUSCH, who was cooperative and provided surveillance video of the incident.
- 15. On 12/02/2019 officers conducted a licensed premise check at Mango's Café East, 1682 N. Van Buren St., believing the tavern was over capacity. The officer spoke with the manager, Jeffrey PARR, asking if he knew what the capacity was and he stated "about 93". The officers asked to see the issued capacity sign and PARR could not locate it. The security at the door estimated there were 60-70 people in the tavern but could not give an accurate count because his "clicker" was broken. PARR was advised to have the capacity posted in view of the public. The officers determined the bar was not over capacity.
- 16. On 12/10/2019 officers along with agents from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 1682 N. Van Buren St. The officers spoke with the manager, Jeffrey PARR, who showed the officers the license and capacity posted in public view. PARR then assisted the Department of Revenue agents in their inspection.
- 17. On 03/17/21 at 11:21pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1682 N. Van Buren Street for a subject with gun complaint. Investigation revealed that there was a fight inside the tavern which was broken up and nobody had a firearm. The owner told officers that the tavern was now closed for the evening, but the officer did observe numerous patrons, inside the tavern, consuming beverages and eating food. The tavern license was observed which was posted inside a small room just off the southern end of the bar.
- 18. On 08/11/21 at 2:20am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1682 N. Van Buren Street for a subject with gun complaint. Investigation revealed that there was a fight inside the establishment and when an employee tried to break up the fight, a subject produced a handgun and started waving it around. The subject then fled in a vehicle. While officers were interviewing the employee, the vehicle that the subject fled in returned and officers found a firearm inside the vehicle. The subject was arrested.
- 19. On 10/04/21 Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up at 1682 N. Van Buren Street on a shots fired complaint which occurred on 10/03/21 at 1627 N. Van Buren Street. Pole camera video, which is located at the intersection of E. Brady Street and N. Van Buren Street, revealed that the shooter and vehicle used in the incident were captured lingering in front of 1682 N. Van Buren Street immediately before the incident. Officers made contact with the General Manager who appeared nervous and evasive in his answers to questions asked of him. He told officers that he did not know the full names of his employees and that they subcontract security. The owner arrived at the tavern and told officers he does not subcontract security and that he was unaware of a shots fired incident but agreed to allow officer's to view video

surveillance. Officers found that the outside surveillance cameras were not functional and were able to get a better description of a person involved in the incident from the surveillance cameras posted on the inside of the establishment.

- 20. On 11/11/21 at 2:16pm, Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up at 1682 N. Van Buren Street. Officers met the owner and informed him of the recent complaints from neighbors regarding his business. The owner said he was aware of the complaints and was in contact with the Alderman's office regarding these complaints. The officers and the owner agreed to set up a meeting to try and resolve some of these complaints.
- 21. On 12/10/21 at 11:30am, a meeting was held at the First District Police Station between representatives of the City of Milwaukee and the owners of 1682 N. Van Buren Street. The reason for the meeting was to discuss numerous complaints that have come to the attention of the police department and alderman's office. The applicant told officials that he has implemented the following changes; he has provided his personal cell phone number to neighbors, has increased his security staff levels, added eight cameras, pat down and metal detector searches on weekends or when they have a DJ, and instructed door security to deny entry to people who appear intoxicated. The police offered fake identification training for security if they thought it would help them succeed.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 1/24/2023 at 11:20 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
