Dear Mr. Wanke:

We are in receipt of your claim for \$4,625.00 for damages that resulted when a branch from a City tree fell and struck your garage at 5701 West Phillip Place on July 9, 2022.

Our investigation reveals that the Forestry Department received a request for emergency service concerning a branch from a City tree that had fallen on a garage on July 9, 2022 at 5701 West Phillip Place. A Forestry crew responded to the request on the same day and removed a branch that had fallen from a City tree. The branch was alive with some evidence of decay at the point of failure, however, it was not visible from the outside of the branch.

In searching their records for the past six years, Forestry was unable to find any requests for service other than the one concerning this incident.

There is no evidence that the City of Milwaukee is liable for damages in this case. As such, we are denying your claim.
