Michelle Holman v. City of Milwaukee, 22CV000235 RE:

Dear Council Members:

This is a supplemental communication regarding the above mentioned case.

On September 18, 2019, Jay Bach, Urban Forestry Specialist, was the operator of a City pick-up truck, when he found a stray DPW sign and placed it in the open bed of this truck without securing it or laying it down. Bach then began traveling southbound on Interstate 43 and the sign flew out of the bed of his truck and landed on the freeway.

Plaintiff, Michelle L. Holman, encountered the sign in her own vehicle and according to her expert, the sign became wedged under the wheel well of Plaintiff's vehicle causing her vehicle to strike a concrete barrier and further causing Plaintiff severe injuries and other damages. Plaintiff's claimed damages total \$1,705,000.57.

Plaintiff filed suit in the Milwaukee County Circuit Court upon a theory of negligent operation of a motor vehicle which carries a \$250,000.00 statutory cap on damages. The Defendant would be liable for that portion of the Plaintiff's damages that could be attributed to his negligence, if any. Any liability would likely be imputed to the City by the doctrine of respondeat superior and by the operation of the government employee indemnification statute. See Wis. Stat. § 895.46(1).
