There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

It seems like the contract is a license to steal from the people of Milwaukee. I was told by one of the managers at All City Towing. That the contract allows him to charge whatever he likes in fact I was informed that there is a special rate charge to the north side of Milwaukee for any tolls pass North Avenue the rate is \$200 extra how is that possible in the most segregated city in the country to allow Redline discrimination of that sort. Unbelievable.

By the way I started a non-profit company to help bring fresh affordable food 2 communities that need better access to Fresh affordable food.

We hire at risk youth and we train them to build and operate small grocery stores in food businesses. I pay for it all with my own money. And I helped dozens of kids.

And me and my kids get fleeced all the time by the city of Milwaukee and the businesses that are contracted through it. And it must stop. The bus they stole was for the benefit of the people of the city of Milwaukee.

On January 3, 2022 at 2:01 PM I conducted follow up at All City Towing, located at 1213 W. Mallory Ave. in the City and County of Milwaukee.

While at the business I spoke with the owner/agent Jeffrey J. Pillier. I advised Pillier that I was conducting a spot check to ask about best practices that his business maybe utilizing.

Pillier stated the following:

His business does not buy scrap cars from the public or conduct repo tows. Any vehicles that are scrapped by the business were unclaimed property and only done after the last know owner is sent a certified letter warning of the unclaimed vehicle. All scrap vehicles are taken to Milwaukee Iron at 4485 N. Green Bay Ave.

All City is contacted by private property owners to conduct illegal parking tows. Before any tows are conducted All City enters into a contract with the legal property agent for a 12 month term. All City will post signs to warn of parking restriction. If a tow is needed, no vehicle is hooked-up before the City Tow desk is contacted and a tow number is generated. Drivers are required to take photos of all four corners and any signs posted on the property.

All tows are logged in "Tow Book" an electronic computer system to keep track of time and photos of every towed vehicle. There is a copy of the City Tow Ordinance at the front desk for all customers to view. All City charges \$150.00 for a tow and tries not to charge for any special equipment use, only if a vehicle requires extra time to remove it. Storage charges are \$25.00 a day and starts after 12 hours the vehicle is secured at the All City lot.

This ended the inspection with All City Towing.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 2/14/2023 at 10:15 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
