On Wednesday, August 10, 2022, I was going to work at about 6:30 am. I saw that the garbage cans were full, and I left for work.




I called the landlady, and I told her what had happened and that it was the City Garbage truck that caused the damage. She asked me to take a picture of the damage and write a statement of the incident.
