Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffit, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. 6. On 05/03/2014 a 19 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to 2220 North Farwell Avenue (Landmark Lanes), but was denied when she could not provide proof that she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.

- 7. On 02/19/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a tavern check and dropped off a packet of tavern related ordinances at 2220 North Farwell Avenue (Landmark Lanes).
- 8. On 02/27/2015 a 18 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to Landmark Lanes (2220 North Farwell Avenue) but was turned away at the door when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
- 9. On 09/11/2015 Milwaukee police were flagged down for a subject down at Landmark Lanes (2220 North Farwell Avenue). Investigation revealed a subject had fallen down a flight of stairs leading into the business. Milwaukee police incident report #150260008 filed.
- 10. On 03/21/2016 a representative of the business attended training held by Milwaukee police at 2022 East North Avenue (BBC Tavern). Officers trained the representatives on how to detect fake identification.
- 11. On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to Landmark Lanes, 2220 N. Farwell Av. The Police Aid was allowed entry by door security and was able to order and pay for a Miller Lite beer.

12. On 03/11/21 at 1:00am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2220 N. Farwell Avenue. The manager was very cooperative and no violations were observed.

- 13. On 04/28/22 Milwaukee Police conducted an Underage Tavern Enforcement Initiative at 2220 N Farwell. At approximately 10:28pm., an underage police aide was able to purchase an alcoholic beverage from the bartender and no identification was requested of the police aide. The bartender was later identified and cited for Sale of Alcohol to Underage. The agent was cited for Allow Underage on Premises.
- 14. On 09/08/22, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2220 N. Farwell Ave., for an Overdose. On arrival an unconscious subject was observed at the bar receiving medical attention from MFD. Security on scene did not appear to have any interest in assisting MPD or MFD. Video Surveillance was requested from the manager, however, upon return to retrieve the video, there was no answer at the door.
- 15. On 12/04/22 at 2:41am., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2220 N. Farwell Av., for a Battery. Investigation revealed a patron became irate when being escorted out of the bar at close. The patron then attacked the security guard and it took multiple employees and another patron to stop the patron's violent attack. The patron was arrested for Assault and Battery. The employees were cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance.

This report was written by PO Fidah MUSTAFA assigned to District 1 Early Power.

On the evening of Thursday, April 28, 2022, District One Personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. Our team consisted of an MPD Police Aide (PA Holly PELZEK PS# 031441), a police officer (PO Erica MARTINEZ PS# 029447), both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity, and Police Officers Fldah MUSTAFA and Timothy KREJCI (Squad 1265) monitoring from a short distance in full duty uniforms. The Police Aide PELZEK is under the age of 21 (the legal age to purchase alcohol). This was verified by their respective Wisconsin Driver's License.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments, the PA PELZEK and PO MARTINEZ were given instructions. All members of this initiative were advised they are not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth, PA PELZEK and PO MARTINEZ, were directed not to produce identification, and to walk away if asked to produce identification. It was explained that the police aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes police officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

After the briefing, the teams conducted underage checks at multiple taverns and convenient stores located throughout the District One Boundaries.

Police Officer MARTINEZ and Police Aide PELZEK gained entry to the class "B" Licensed Tavern at 10:28 PM, Landmark Lanes located at 2220 N. Farwell Av. PA PELZEK successfully purchased a glass of Sprite & Crown Royal alcoholic beverage, the bartender, did not ask PA PELZEK for identification and completed the sale for a Sprite & Crown Royal mixed drink for the amount of \$9. PA PELZEK exited Landmark Lanes at 9:56 PM.

Based on PO MARTINEZ's description follow-up was conducted at Landmark Lanes. On Saturday April 30, 2022 at 1:18 PM, and spoke with the Class "B" Licensee Slava TUZHILKOV (W/M 108-30-1968), who identified himself as the licensee of Landmark Lanes. TUZHILOV stated that I would have to talk to his manager "Kevin" and identify the bartender who served the underaged customer. At 6:00pm I talked to manager, Kevin S. GLASS (w/m 09-04-1975), by phone and GLASS identified the bartender as Jacob R. SILI (W/M 02-18-1997), who was working and has a tattoo on his left elbow of an anchor and chain.

SILI was served a citation # 0681C3B00F, along with a MC-715 form and a PF-6 in person for the sale of an alcoholic beverage to an underage customer, By PO KREJCI on Saturday, April 30, 2022 at 12:30 PM. Court date of October 24, 2022 at 8:30 AM.

TUZHILKOV was served a citation # 0681C3B003 along with a MC-715 form and a PF-6 in person for sale to underage regarding licensee or permittee, By PO KREJCI on Saturday, April 30, 2022 at 12:30 PM. Court date of October 24, 2022 at 8:30 AM

A B/M was observed in the bar area unconscious with MFD providing medical attention. The business remained open and the security showed no interest in assisting MPD, MFD. I contacted the manager on duty Kevin S. GLASS (W/M 09-04-1975) who stated that I could retrieve video footage the next day Friday September 9, 2022 at 3:00 PM. I called Landmark Lanes on Friday, September 9, 2022 at 2:45 PM, and knocked on the business door multiple times with no answer.

This report is being written by P.O. Robert MOY, assigned to District #1, Late Shift, Squad 1332. On Sunday December 4, 2022, at 2:41 AM, while in full duty uniform equipped with an Axon body worn camera activated and in a marked squad, I along with P.O. HERNANDEZ-MAESTRE were dispatched to a Battery complaint at Oriental Landmark Classic Lanes located at 2220 N Farewell Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Interview of JAMES(Suspect)

Upon arrival I spoke to one of the caller/suspects, later identified as Romia L. JAMES B/F 02-13-1998 (262 -259-9135). JAMES stated she was at Oriental Landmark Classic Lanes which is located at the address listed above, with her friend Darvell. JAMES stated Darvell was being too friendly with another female at the bar. JAMES stated she went to ask the female why she was being friendly with Darvell and if this unknown female-was with Darvell. JAMES stated Darvell got upset that she was asking about him and started fighting with her. Darvell stated that there were no other reasons as to why Darvell attacked her.

Interview of Weary (Victim)

I spoke to the victim, later identified as Darvell T. WEARY B/M 09-25-1991(414-207-3707) WEARY stated he is a security guard at Oriental Landmark Classic Lanes. WEARY stated it was bar closing time and he was escorting patrons out of the bar. WEARY stated he started to escort JAMES out the establishment. WEARY stated when they got to the front of the entrance JAMES got mad at him. WEARY started that earlier he had removed two of JAMES male friends during bar close and she was irate about it. WEARY stated to avoid confrontation he decided to go back in the bar to get help. WEARY stated he was walking

back downstairs to the bar, when JAMES intentionally threw her phone at him. WEARY stated he then tossed the phone back to JAMES and that is when JAMES started to chase him down the stairs. WEARY stated JAMES started to scratch and punch him, and he defended himself. WEARY stated that is when the bar manager came and broke up the fight and helped escorted JAMES out of the establishment. I observed that WEARY suffered minor scratches to the left side of his face close to the left eye. WEARY decline medical attention but stated that he would go to the hospital later.

Interview of Linehan (Witness)

I spoke to the bar manager/witness, later identified as Kyle N. LINEHAN W/M 11-05-1988 (414-885-8819). LINEHAN stated he really don't know what started the incident but saw JAMES fighting WEARY at the end of the staircase. LINEHAN stated that is when he jumped in to help escort JAMES out of the establishment. LINEHAN stated he was able to escort JAMES out of the establishment and lock the door but during the process, he was bitten by JAMES serval times on the left forearm. At the time of the incident, I was unable to observe any visible bite marks, abrasions, or redness where the alleged biting occurred. JAMES denied any medical and declined to be a victim but will be a witness to the incident.

Video Footage P.O HERNANDEZ-MAESTRE and I were able to look at the video of the incident. The video shows the following: At 2:35AM you see WEARY trying to escort JAMES out of the establishment. WEARY and JAMES have some type of argument at the front entrance. A short time later you see WEARY walk down the stairs and JAMES throws her phone at him. You see WEARY toss the phone back at JAMES but not in an aggressive manner. A few seconds later JAMES starts running down the stairs and assaults JAMES by scratching and punching him. LINEHAN then step in and help escorts JAMES out of the establishment. During the video I observed JAMES attempt to attack WEARKY multiple times and it took an unknown female friend and other bar staff to stop her.

Video footage was documented via body camera, and I requested a copy of the video footage JAMES was taken into custody and conveyed to District #1.

JAMES was cited for Assault and Battery and released with a future court date.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 3/7/2023 at 9:30 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
