

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This report was written by Police Officer Fabian Garcia assigned to squad 6264, CLO/CPU.

On Wednesday, December 28, 2022, at 2:30 pm, my partner Officer Ward and I met with licensee/agent Maria Y. Camacho. Mrs. Camacho stated that they plan on opening up this location as a creative studio for youth and their families.

Mrs. Camacho stated that they plan to be open from Monday-Saturday and they are currently under construction. Mrs. Camacho stated they would like to add exterior lights and security cameras but would have to see if that would be possible to add anything to the exterior of the property. Mrs. Camacho stated they plan on adding approximately 8 to 9 interior security cameras. 4 to 5 cameras will be installed in the Café/bar area, one camera in the hallway, which leads to the studio, and 3 cameras inside of the actual studio, which is located in the rear of the property. Mrs. Camacho stated that only a studio manager and her husband and she will have access to surveillance footage. Discussion was had regarding the placement of cameras.

Mrs. Camacho stated they plan on posting "No Loitering" signs as well to the front of the property. There is a gangway that is located between their property and the building to the east of them. Mrs. Camacho and her husband stated that they are already in contact with the property owner of the building to the east of them to go half and half on a fence for that gangway. Mrs. Camacho and her husband were provided with a District resource guide.

No additional comments/recommendations at this time.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 3/7/2023 at 9:45 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


