The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

On 07/19/21 at 8:54pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 2438 W.
Hopkins Street. The only violation found was that the establishment had video gaming
machines and did not have a PEP license. The applicant was informed that he needed a PEP
license if he was going to operate the gaming machines.

2. On 11/08/22 at 8:55pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2438 W. Hopkins Street for a battery/cutting compliant. INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by Police Officer Evan BILLER, assigned to District 5 Early shift, squad 5220(PO Brian PFEIL).

On Tuesday November 8, 2022 at approximately 8:55 p.m., my partner and I were dispatched to the address of 2438 W Hopkins St (Mother Food and Deli) in the city and county of Milwaukee to investigate a Battery cutting complaint.

Upon arrival we observed an unknown white male lying inside the door way with a stab wound to the right side of his back. The male that was stabbed was later identified as Ankit BHALLA (W/M, 06-30-2000). BHALLA is an employee at Mother Food and Deli, who attempted to confront a shoplifter about walking out with item's and was then stabbed during the incident.

The owner of the business who was verbally identified as Gurcharan SINGH (W/M, 04-01-1958) later showed up on scene to help officers and detectives reviewing video surveillance. SINGH was cooperative with police investigation and gave detectives and officers all the information they asked for.

The video on scene that officers reviewed showed the unknown suspect was by the coolers when he started to stuff chips and other items in his coat he was wearing. The unknown suspect then started to walk towards the entrance/exit door, when BHALLA who was sitting on a stool next to the checkout counter, got up from his seat to confront the unknown suspect. When BHALLA got up words were exchanged between the two parties, when BHALLA turned to speak with workers behind the counter, the unknown suspect pulled a knife from his waistband and stabbed BHALLA to his back once before fleeing the scene on foot.

The victim of the incident is an employee/ security on scene, which needed surgery to close up his stab wound to his lower back.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
