RE: Request to Extend Probationary Period – Adrian Woods

Dear City Service Commissioners:

DPW Operations Division respectfully requests to extend the probationary period for Adrian Woods, who was hired as a Lead Parking Enforcement Officer, September 4, 2022 and is subject to a 6-month probationary period scheduled to end on March 4, 2023.

Mr. Woods's overall performance has met job requirements, but he has had some issues developing into the new role. The department has identified three areas that require improvement. Those areas include accurately entering citation information, providing guidance and leadership as well as well as training to new and current Parking Enforcement Officers and learning and retaining City Ordinances related to parking citations. The department believes the recent change in management played a large part in Mr. Woods not being trained efficiently. The department has put together a performance improvement plan covering these three deficiencies to ensure Mr. Woods success. DPW requests his probationary period be extended three months to June 4, 2023.
