Dear City Service Commission,

DPW Infrastructure Division respectfully requests to extend the probationary period for Candace Nellum who was hired as a City Laborer, June 6, 2022 and is subject to a 9-month probationary period that was scheduled to end on March 6, 2023.

Ms. Nellum's overall performance has met job requirements, but due to a lack of CDL trainers she has not obtained the required Commercial Driver's license within six months of her appointment to the position. Infrastructure will continue to partner with DPW Fleet to provide the required 40 hours of entry level driver training (ELDT) classroom instruction. DPW requests her probationary period be retroactively extended nearly six months, beginning March 6, 2023 and ending August 31, 2023.
