

MSOE – COMMITTED TO MILWAUKEE

- Over past 6 years, MSOE has invested over \$100 million in major campus improvements.
- A recent study by company Lightcast found that MSOE added \$155 million in economic impact to the City of Milwaukee in 2021-22.
- 310 E. Knapp St. will be renovated to be new home of MSOE's Dept. of Civil and Architectural Engr. and Construction Management. (Dept. is currently severely limited in space, plus space is poor quality.)
- Graduates of these majors are in <u>extremely</u> high demand by local companies (100% placement rate in 2022).
- New building will allow program growth.
- Estimated total renovation cost is \$14 million. Will be funded through philanthropy.
- Phased renovation with Phase 1 completed fall 2024 (begin academic use).
