Property Description of work

2569 N Wahl Ave, North Point North

Hardscape elements will be incorporated into the design to provide a functional and visually appealing landscape. The existing back brick patio is to be removed and replaced by a new 946 sq ft patio in the layout as shown on the scaled plan provided. The selection of a tumbled bluestone patio and walk is based on the site's historical context and the design concept. Flagstone steppers will allow access through the front foundation planting bed.

The plants proposed were selected for their suitability for the region and site maintenance. As well as staying within the character of the historical neighborhood. A back screening of evergreens will create a buffer between properties. The new plantings will provide a mix of deciduous and evergreen shrubs and trees with a ground cover of perennials. All lawn areas will be repaired and reseeded after construction is completed.

All proposed path lights will be installed in the back yard. Some ornamental trees will be lit with uplights from within the planting beds.




