New brick will be installed with mortar similar in color and texture to the mortar joints in the existing unaffected areas of the structure. Mortar joints will be tooled and finished to match the exiting unaffected mortar joints in the structure.

Existing stone copings will be reinstalled on the top course of the new brick walls

Remove damaged concrete inside the existing front porch of the structure, install stone and compact to prevent concrete from settling. New concrete will be installed to the existing diimensions
