REASON FOR REQUEST:

Richard McCormick, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Locust Street. As the city vehicle was approaching the intersection of West Locust Street and North 38<sup>th</sup> Street, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound in an alley between North 37<sup>th</sup> Street and North 38<sup>th</sup> Street, entered West Locust Street and failed to yield the right of way striking the city vehicle causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer McCormick sustained injuries to his head, neck, and low back. The treating physician indicated that the low back injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$80,937.58.
