




# MATC Electrical Power Distribution (EPD) Program - Proposed

# Cooperation Agreement and License Agreement

- Cooperation Agreement:
  - RACM will construct facility on behalf of MATC, as part of an overall remediation and grading project
  - MATC Foundation will facilitate funding of the facility utilizing an escrow account (\$234,000)
  - Parties will agree on future steps
- License Agreement:
  - Terms:
    - Initial term 01/01/23 12/31/24
    - Three one-year renewal options
  - \$1 license fee
  - MATC will maintain the facility
