Dear Ms. Farrell:

At a public hearing held on May 1, 2023, the Historic Preservation Commission, by a vote of six (6) ayes and one (1) excused, recommended permanent historic designation of the above property as an historic structure in accordance with provisions of Section 320-21-9 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, based upon criteria of s. 320-21-3-e-1, e-5, and e-8.

Section 320-21-9 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances provides that the Common Council shall review the recommendation of the commission and take final action. You will be notified of the time and location of the Common Council Zoning, Neighborhoods & Development Committee hearing if you wish to speak further on the matter.
