Current Zoning:	Detailed Planned Development (DPD) known as Airport Business Center
Proposed <u>Zoning:</u>	Minor Modification to Airport Business Center DPD
<u>Proposal:</u>	The subject file relates to a Minor Modification to the Detailed Planned Development known as Airport Business Center to allow changes to the Culver's drive-through facility located at 575 West Layton Avenue, on the south side of West Layton Avenue, east of South 6th Street, in the 13th Aldermanic District.
	The modification will reduce the current parking count from 66 spaces to 59 spaces to accommodate a second drive through lane. Two drive-through pod order points will be added and the existing order point will be relocated. These changes will require some curb and paving improvements as well as parking lot restriping.
Adjacent Land Use:	Adjacent properties on Layton Ave consist of Local Business (LB1) and Industrial Light (IL1) zoning districts. Properties west of the subject site across 6 th St. are designated as Single Family Residential (RS6.)
Consistency with	
<u>Area Plan:</u>	The Culver's located at 575 W. Layton Ave is located within the Southeast Side Area Plan, adopted by the Common Council in 2008, and the Aerotropolis Development Plan, adopted by the Common Council in 2017. The proposed improvements to the site layout and operations is consistent with the Plans' goals of supporting retail and hospitality in this area.
