080.30 MPD ADMINISTRATION OF THE FMLA IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CITY'S FMLA POLICY

Pursuant to the state and federal laws, the City of Milwaukee's administration of the FMLA benefit includes the following:

I. The department may deny a Sick Leave Incentive Control award to an employee who does not have perfect attendance because of taking FMLA leave. An employee does not earn a Sick Leave Incentive Control award during the same trimester when sick leave is used, including sick leave for FMLA.
