There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing. You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below. This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

 On 07/14/2018 officers conducted a licensed premise check at Boone & Crockett, 818 S Water St. The officers spoke with the manager, Katrina CRAY, about the business capacity. CRAY stated they do not let in more than 275 people. The officer observed a sign posted stating the capacity was 292 people. No violations were observed.

- 2. On 05/17/2019 at 6:17pm officers were dispatched to a dog bite at Boone & Crocket, 818 S. Water St. The officer interviewed the victim who stated he was walking past the inside bar when a dog that was sitting on the floor bite him on the thigh. The owner of the dog was sitting next to the dog when it happened but did not witness the incident. The staff of the tavern was cooperative with the officers. Boone & Crocket is a dog friendly establishment.
- 3. On 06/20/22 at 6:39pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 818 S. Water Street for a theft complaint. Surveillance footage revealed a subject entered the main entrance of the tavern, took three laptop computers from the DJ booth, and exited through the front entrance.

- 4. On 08/12/22 at 1:00pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 818 S. Water Street for a theft complaint. Investigation revealed that an employee left her purse inside a shack, right behind the boat dock, and somebody took it. There was no surveillance footage.
- 5. On 08/14/22 at 1:18am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 818 S. Water Street for a fight complaint. The CAD system stated that there was a fight at the location and the event coordinator wanted three highly intoxicated attendees to leave. Police responded and advised the call.
- 6. On 10/30/22 at 11:30pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 818 S. Water Street for an overdose complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject ingested MDMA and alcohol which made her sick. The subject was transported to the hospital and no violations were observed on the premise.
- 7. On 11/06/22 at 12:50am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 818 S. Water Street for a threat complaint. Investigation revealed that a man was found lying in the parking lot and when staff tried to assist him, he became vulgar and aggressive. The officers remained on scene until the subject left and advised the caller.
- 8. On 03/12/23 at 12:48am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 818 S. Water Street for a trouble with subject complaint. Investigation revealed that a subject tried to force himself into the tavern and upon police arrival, the subject left. Police advised the employees.

This report is written by City of Milwaukee Police Officer Nicholas ZARAGOZA, assigned to District Two, on Early Power Shift.

On Wednesday, July 06, 2022, at 5:55PM, myself along with my partner P.O. Eric ROBILLARD, were dispatched to 818 S. Water St. (Boone and Crockett Bar), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI, to investigate a theft complaint. My axon body worn camera was activated for this investigation.

Upon arrival, we spoke with the owner, later identified as Emily C. DELL (W/F 10-23-1987), who stated on Monday, June 20, 2022, at approximately 6:49PM, an unknown white male, wearing a light-colored shirt and dark colored pants, entered the location and permanently deprived her of three laptops from her business.

I spoke with DELL further regarding this incident who stated she is the owner of Boone and Crockett Bar and owns the three laptops that were taken. DELL stated her business is closed on Monday, but on 06-20-2022 her employee (Dan), entered the business to water plants and conduct work related business. DELL stated Dan arrived at 5:40PM and began working inside. DELL stated Dan left the entrance door unlocked and open while he was there. DELL stated Dan clocked out at approximately 7:05PM, locked the business, and left for the night.

DELL stated on 06-21-2022 she arrived at her business and discovered her three laptops missing from the DJ booth where they are normally kept. DELL stated she last observed the three laptops on Sunday, June 19, 2022, when she closed for the night. DELL stated she reviewed video surveillance on 06-20-2022 and that is when she observed the unknown male subject enter the business and permanently deprive her of her property. Below is a following synopsis of the video surveillance:

- At 6:40PM, the suspect enters the business through the main entrance and is seen

looking around, walking towards the DJ booth located in the southeastern corner of the building.

- At 6:42PM, the suspect is then seen taking all three laptops from the DJ booth.

- At 6:43PM, the suspect then leaves the business through the main entrance doorway in an unknown direction.

There are no cameras on the exterior of the building.

Further follow up will be conducted to locate other cameras and check for the stolen laptops at pawn shops.

This concludes my report.

On Friday, August 12th, 2022, PO ROMEO and I, were dispatched to 818 S. Water St. which is in the City and County of Milwaukee WI, for a theft complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke with caller/ victim identified as Alexandria A. HERNANDEZ (w/f 11-16-2003) who stated on the above listed day and date between the hours of 1:00pm and 8:00pm \$130 cash, social security card and several miscellaneous cards were taken from her Michael Kors purse.

HERNANDEZ stated she was at work and left her purse as she usually does inside the shack right behind the boat dock. HERNANDEZ stated the shack is usually not locked but the door was closed to it. HERNANDEZ stated she had other valuable items inside her purse and nothing else was taken. HERNANDEZ stated she kept her cash and cards tied together and not in any particular wallet. HERNANDEZ stated she had all twenty-dollar bills and two \$1 bills. HERNANDEZ stated she does not know of there being any cameras in the area and contacted her boss regarding but was unable to make contact.

No witnesses on scene during time of incident.

HERNANDEZ stated she received a notification from her bank stating there was a \$534.73 transaction at the Speedway gas station located at 4225 W Burnham St. which is in the City and County of Milwaukee WI. HERNANDEZ stated she contacted the Speedway and they advised her they would not help if she did not obtain a police report.

PO ROMEO and I went to the Speedway to observe the video surveillance and we were advised to come back Monday August 15th, 2022, due to not having anyone with the video capability.

HERNANDEZ was given a PV-17.

HERNANDEZ cancelled all credit cards prior to police arrival.

HERNANDEZ did not have another further information regarding the incident and stated she has never been a victim of theft before.

On Sunday October 30th, 2022, at approximately 11:30 PM with an Axon body worn camera on and activated, my partner PO James SPINATO and I responded to 818 S. Water St (City and County of Milwaukee) for an overdose complaint.

Upon arrival I made contact with the caller- Madeline B. SUTER(W/F 12/23/1987). SUTER stated that she is the event coordinator for "The Cooperage" and when she arrived at work she observed Monica M. ZIMMER(W/F 07/29/1981) on the ground rolling around and in a disoriented state. SUTER stated that she spoke with ZIMMER and ZIMMER's boyfriend and they stated to her that they just took "Molly". SUTER called 911 and ZIMMER's boyfriend stated that he has a record and had to leave.

MFD Engine 23 and Med 15(Green shift, Lt. NOBLE) responded to the scene and checked the vitals of ZIMMER. MED 15 transported ZIMMER to St. Francis Hospital where she was admitted at 12:08 AM and treated by Dr. KAHN.

I spoke with ZIMMER who was disoriented and was unable to focus on my questions. ZIMMER stated that she had ingested a blue pill of MDMA as well as snorted an unknown amount of white powdered MDMA at approximately 11:00 PM. ZIMMER stated that she was also drinking alcohol with the narcotics. ZIMMER stated that she got the MDMA from a friend of a friend.

No violations observed at the premises.






