Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

North Av. The clerk did not ask for ID. The clerk stated he did not ask for ID but asked what year she was born in, and she responded 1997. Since this was a Class A Liquor store the officer asked for the clerks Bartender's license, and the clerk did not have one. The manager was contacted by phone and she stated she was on her way there. The manager arrived while the officer was on scene. She stated the clerk was just re-hired and she thought he had a bartender's license. The manager was advised the applicant would receive a citation for Sale of Cigarette to Minor/Underage.

- On 04/28/22 at 8:55pm, Milwaukee Police conducted an underage tavern enforcement initiative at 1609 E. North Avenue. The establishment did sell an underage Police Aide a 12 pack of alcoholic beverages. The clerk who sold the item was cited.

This report was written by PO Fidah MUSTAFA assigned to District 1 Early Power.

On the evening of Thursday, April 28, 2022, District One Personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. Our team consisted of an MPD Police Aide (PA Holly PELZEK PS# 031441), a Police Officer (PO Erica MARTINEZ PS# 029447), both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity, Police Officers Fidah MUSTAFA and Timothy KREJCI (Squad 1265) were monitoring from a short distance in full duty uniforms. The Police Aide PELZEK is under the age of 21 (the legal age to purchase alcohol). This was verified by their respective Wisconsin Driver's License.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments, the PA PELZEK and PO MARTINEZ were given instructions. All members of this initiative were advised they are not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth. PA PELZEK and PO MARTINEZ, were directed not to produce identification, and to walk away if asked to produce identification. It was explained that the Police Aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes police officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

After the briefing, the teams conducted underage checks at multiple taverns and convenience stores located throughout the **District One Boundaries.**

Police Officer MARTINEZ and Police Aide PELZEK gained entry to the Class "A" Licensed Establishment at 8:55 PM, 7-Eleven located at 1609 E. North Av. PA PELZEK successfully purchased a 12 pack of Cayman Jack AlCOhOlic Margarita Beverage, the clerk did not ask PA PELZEK for identification and completed the sale for a 12 pack of Cayman Jack Alcoholic Margarita Beverage for the amount of S21. PA PELZEK exited the 7-Eleven at 8:57 PM.

This report is written by P.O. Irving HERNANDEZ-MAESTRE, assigned to District 1, Late Shift.

On Wednesday, 07/06/2022 at 04:00 AM, I responded to an entry complaint at 7 Eleven located at 1609 E North Av. Upon my arrival at 04:03 AM, I observed an unused door to the south of the main entrance window was shattered with glass on the ground. P.O. Jonathan ECHAVARRIA (Squad 1320) and I conducted a search of the location for any confederates. It should be noted that the main front entrance to the store was open and automatically opened up for us.

We were unable to get into the locked storage room but did not find anyone inside. I observed that the front register area was ransacked and that tobacco products appeared to be the intended target. It did not appear that the register itself was damage.

While on scene I heard the back door open, and I observed a black male walk out of the locked storage room. I recognized the subject to be the third shift worker and he later identified himself as Demetrice T GREENLEE (B/M, 05-11-95). Demetrice stated he came out of the backroom to speak to us. I asked Demetrice what happened, and he stated that he was making coffee in the coffee aisle and heard the window shatter, and it sounded like a gunshot to him. Demetrice stated that he got scared and went to the back room and locked it. Demetrice stated that he watched on camera the suspects enter the store and take items before fleeing the scene.

I asked Demetrice if he called 911 and he stated that he did not. I asked him why he didn't call 911 and he stated that he didn't have a phone. I asked Demetrice if he had a cell phone and he stated that he did not. I asked Demetrice if he knew that a phone was inside the back office, and he stated that he did not know there was one there.
