Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing. You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Hello,

I need your assistance. My Tesla Model X was towed from a lot that was not marked as private or no parking! The tow company - Junk Junkies LLC and Anthony Booher. This was clear fraud and opportunistic on their part as there were several vehicles parked nearby that were not towed. They knew they could get \$300 out of me. It is effectively ENTRAPMENT showing unmarked spots and then towing vehicles and extorting owners out of \$300. A short scan of his CCAP will reveal the why's I believe.

This individual has 22 charges against him on CCAP alone, including domestic abuse, gun violence, etc. This company fraudulently took my vehicle. Photos are attached about where I parked. The area was a gravel lot that appeared to have public parking in the unmarked spots.

They charged nearly \$300 for this and wasted a ton of time. They didn't answer my repeated calls. The family I had to leave there has video of their predatory practices circling the area 3 times within 20 minutes looking for more fraudulent tow opportunities.

This company charged moved my vehicle without authorization and held me up for \$285 cash because they wouldn't accept credit card. That's not legal either as it's my understanding they must post their payment methods and accept the posted methods. They posted credit cards as an option and didn't take them.

I believe they wanted to tow the tesla because they never had. Their employee admitted this.

I would like to see their license revoked, my money refunded, and the business fined for their illegal acts violating WisStat Trans 319. Please get back to me ASAP.

I have photos of the area I parked showing it was entirely unmarked. We have witnesses of the number of times they circled trying to entrap others. This is not a good business/owner and need to be stopped.

Good evening Mr. Kovac,

11 researched and found a Fox6news report from July 24,2019 in which you were My name is! apart of to crack down on towing "special fees." Today I was parked in a lot across from Float Milwaukee and Purple Door Ice Cream Shop, located at the corner of 2nd and Freshwater. I was there for a short moment to pick up a donation ffrom Float Milwaukee for an upcoming nonprofit event and had my four year old daughter with me. There were five stalls marked for Float Milwaukee Parking and about 20 feet away was a sign that said no parking and a Purple Door Mini Truck was parked in front of that sign, the 10 feet between the two areas was not marked at all with visible signage to indicate that area was a no parking zone for either Float Milwaukee or Purple Door. I parked in the area right next to the Float Milwaukee stall 5 sign. I was notified by the Float Milwaukee staff my car was being towed and I should go out right away because "the tow company had been getting people all day for stupid reasons and demanding cash payments to unhook the car. I ran outside with my four year old and asked the tow driver what he was doing. He told me "if you give me 50 or 100 right now I will unhook your car." I told him I did not have cash but had credit cards, he said he can't take that he needed cash so I told him this was extortion and I was going to call the police. As I proceeded to put my daughter in the car and call the police he knocked my phone out of my hand, grabbing me by the arm to stop me from bending down to pick it up and choked me and said "bitch you need to just pay what you owe the police are gonna be on my side." at this point my daughter is crying hysterically for him to stop. I started yelling and as he saw others watching he backed up and I hurried to get in the car grabbing my phone to call the police and locking my doors. he stood behind the car with his tow truck backed up to my car but not connected. When the police arrived they saw the bruising on my arms and asked me what I wanted to do I said I wanted to press charges, the indicated it was my word against the drivers (although I clearly have marks on my body). I asked for a supervisor who came on the scene and once on the scene he indicated I could press charges and the driver would get a simple assault charge (no police report was taken or photos other than those I took were taken of my arm clearly showing red brusing up and down). The officers also talked to my four year old daughter who indicated to them what happened also, and told them she was scared for her mommy.

After sitting for some time so the officers could contact the owner of the lot at my request to let him know what happened they told me I would need to pay the 50 dollars, and asked me again if I wanted to press charges. I said yes, After indicating I wanted to press charges the tow driver decided he now wanted to charge me \$350 and he told the officers this. I asked the officers how they could allow this and they said I would need to sort it out in civil court they couldnt do anything about the extra charges at that time. One of the officers did indicate the tow driver told them his normal charge was \$299. I am so in shock that all of this happened in front of Milwaukee Police and they stood by and watched it take place. I am also in shock that after bringin up the ordinance so the officers can see it on my phone and clearly reading it was illegal to overcharge they allowed this to happen. The name of the towing company is MKE Junk Junkies and the tow driver was Anthony Booher.

I don't know if this will fall upon deaf ear but I thought I would try to see if someone would lead me in the right direction to get help and have my story heard. This was assault, extortion and very poor police work and I don't even know where to begin. I have no criminal record and have never been in the crinimal justice system. I have only ever had a speeding ticket and I just don't know how, who or where to begin.

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
