There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. On Tuesday, October 4th, 2022, I was assigned to regular patrol duties on Squad 5438 along with P.O. Darius WADE. We were operating a fully marked City of Milwaukee Police Department Squad Car, Vehicle 514, and were in full M.P.D. uniforms with operating Axon mobile body worn cameras during this investigation.

On Tuesday, October 4th, 2022, at 7:33PM, we responded to an Entry complaint at 3501 N. 6th St which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival I spoke to the caller identified as WHITE, Anthony D., (B/M, DOB- 06/18/65) who stated he is the tenant of the building, and the building was broken into. WHITE stated earlier in the morning at approximately 3:00AM on 10/04/22 he made a report regarding the same incident that occurred. (Reference IR# 22-277-0019).

WHITE stated both back and the front of the business doors were boarded up from the previous incident but stated the front boarded up door was ripped off. WHITE stated there were three machines that were damaged and opened to access the box where money was stored. I observed three slot machines that were located to the left of the business right when you walk inside. The machines are owned by Mitchell Novelty. One of the machines were named Hocus Pocus and it was disclosed the machine was worth \$2,000. The other machine was named All Stars and was disclosed it was worth \$2,000. The third slot machine was named the Banilla and it was disclosed it was worth \$10,000. There was a Juke Box located further inside the building that was also damaged and it was disclosed it was worth \$4,000. All damages that were caused came to a total of \$18,000. WHITE stated he didn't know how much was taken from the machines and advised us he was going to contact District Five once he found out how much cash was taken from the machines. WHITE stated nothing else was taken or damaged.

WHITE stated there are cameras on the business building, but WHITE was unable to show me surveillance footage of the incident and I do not know exactly what the face and where they are located.

I spoke with another subject that was on scene identified as FISHER, Jeffrey A., (W/M, DOB- 11/01/72). FISHER disclosed to me he is the contractor for the company J.E.D. Investments, in which the business The house of Soul Lounge is a part of J.E.D. Investments. It was also disclosed that WHITE is the owner of the building and is just leasing the building to J.E.D. Investments for that business.

It is unknown at this time how many employees the business has.

All subjects we talked to that night, were cooperative.

This report is written by PO James TERRELL, assigned to District Five Late Power Shift, squad 5468 with PO Nora BURLO.

On Saturday, March 11, 2023, at approximately 10:12PM, PO BURLO and I, conducted a tavern check at 3501 N 6th St (House of Soul Lounge LCC), which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, PO BURLO and I spoke with subject identify as Anthony WHITE (M/B, DOB 06/18/1965) who stated he is the Bar Manager at the location. I observed WHITE to have a Class D Operator's License (BART-21-03498, EFF. DATE: 06/21/2022-EXP. DATE: 12/31/2031) visibly posted behind the bar area. I did not observe a Bar Managers License. PO BURLO spoke with the bartender at the location who was identified as Chukwuka OBI (M/B, DOB 06/05/1986) who stated he only works at the location once every three months and just assisting when the location is short staffed. OBI stated he does not have a bartender's license and is bartending under WHITE.

WHITE was cooperative in this investigation. I observed the location to have eight surveillance cameras viewing the interior and exterior of the premise. I observed to have an occupancy sign posted with a (80) person limit.

PO BURLO and I conducted a walkthrough of the location. Upon walking in the basement of the location, WHITE stated ice is the only item stored there. P BURLO opened the deep freezer which contained one large bag of ice and scattered ice in the inside on the bottom of the deep freezer. PO BURLO and I observed the inside of the deep freezer to be visibly dirty which will likely contaminate the ice which is served to patrons.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
