Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffit, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. On the listed day, date time I responded to the listed location for a noise nuisance. The caller stated he could hear loud music coming from the tavern while in his residence at 810 S. 3rd St.

Upon arrival at the tavern I observed two large windows on the front of the building to be open with a DJ playing loud music that could be easily heard on the street.

I spoke with the bar manager who identified himself as Luis LIU LUEVANO (W/M, 3/30/99). I advised Lius that he needed to keep the door and windows closed if he would be playing loud music to which he complied. Luis was cooperative and compliant throughout my encounter with him.

On August 18, 2022, Milwaukee Police were notified of a Noise Nuisance, which the caller stated the bar across the street from his house is too loud. This call was combined to an additional call complaining about multiple bars on S 2nd St playing loud music but by the time the squad was dispatched the noise had stopped.

On September 19, 2022, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to the premise for a Noise Nuisance, which the caller stated that the premise had the bass from their music shaking his windows. The premise was closed when police arrived.

On December 10, 2022, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to the premise for a Noise Nuisance, which the caller stated that the premise had loud music coming from inside. Officers spoke with the complainant over the phone.

On March 21, 2023, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to the premise for a Noise Nuisance, which the caller stated that the premise had loud music with a lot of bass coming from the location over the last 45 minutes. Police responded and advised the premise of the complaint.

All calls were called in by the same caller. The August 18th combined called had two additional callers.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
