Recently myvehicle was towed by Brew City Towing of 4030 W, Douglas Avenue from 2520 N. Martin Luther King Drive for parking in a space with no permit (private tow). I made a quick stop to dentist and the car was already gone when I returned shortly afterwards.

I wish to file a formal complaint against Brew City, damage was incurred to my car by way of placement of it next to another car in the tow yard (scratched). Also Brew City charged the maximum amount allowed by sate law and still added a full \$25 storage fee for a mere 2 hours and a "SPECIAL EQUIPMENT" charge on my bill for \$105. There is no way that special equipment was required for te manner and location in which my car was parked. It is apparent that Brew City is padding the bill to increase the amount that the vehicle owner needs to pay them to retrieve their vehicle back.

This practice is dishonest and an abuse to the citizens facing this situation. Please process this notification as a complaint against Brew City Toward advise if any further action of me is required at this time. I would like to help end this unfair practice and rip-off scam!

While at this location, PO PARKER and I came into contact with:

PARKER and I explained the allegations of damage to BLAS however he was adamant that he did not clamage vehicle in any manner while he was in possession of it and that any damages that we're on or done to provide must have been there prior to him towing the vehicle. It is that that it is possible that the vehicle sustained damaged tires while moving the vehicle throughout the low lot due to the lots terraine.

Also while speaking with 3 I requested to view the company's video surveillance which igged in and allowed PO PARKER and I to access. Upon logging into the system it should be noted that we were unable to view any video on 3/3/23 as, according to 3, the system only records for six days. This being the case PO PARKER and I were unable to obtain video of the incident.



Physical Assault

You have been examined today because of a physical assault. The assault may have included being his, cheeked (strangled), smothered, kicked, or sexually essaulted.

After a trauma like an assault, it's normal to feel many strong emotions. These may include share, embarrasament, fear, and sadness. They may also include blame, guilt, shame, and anger, for a while, you may not be able to think clearly it can take time to get back to the point where you feel safe again, Crisis support and counseling can help

Many states need your healthcare provider to call local police after treating a victim of a violent crime. This doesn't mean that you have to press charges or go to trial. Talk with your healthcare provider about your options.

You may be able to get a refund of medical costs or losses related to the assault. Ask your local police or victim's advocate for details.

Home care

These tips may help at home:

 Being upset, stressed, or shocked may prevent you from noticing any pain or injury you have. If you have any new symptoms, call your healthcare provider.

Follow your healthcare provider's advice about the care of any injuries you have. To help ease swelling and pair for
the first day or two, put an ice pack on the injured, bruised area for up to 20 minutes. Do this as often as directed
You can make an ice pack by filling a plastic bag that seals at the top with ice cubes. Wrap the bag with a clean,
thin towel. Never put an ice pack directly on the skin.

 Don't isolate yourself. Consider having someone you feel safe with stay with you for a few days. Talk to friends or family about how you are feeling. For the next few days, you might stay with family or a friend for support and to help you feel safe.

If family and friends intentionally or unintentionally cause you more stress, ask the victim's advocate for the name
of a crisis counselor. Short-term emotional support can be very helpful.

 - · Identification (Social Security numbers, birth certificates, photo identification, passports, and visa)
 - Important documents (marriage license, divorce papers, custody papers, and health insurance)
 - Duplicate keys (car, home, and safety deposit box)
 - Telephone numbers and addresses
 - Cash
 - A 1-month supply of medicines

- 6. On 12/15/20 Milwaukee Police received information regarding an over charge of a non-consensual tow for a citizen at Brew City Towing, located at 4030 W. Douglas Av. Investigation revealed the tow was illegal as there was no signed contract with the apartment complex, nor proper posting of tow signs, as well as the overcharge for the vehicle owner being uninsured. The agent was cooperative and agreed to refund the citizens money.
- 7. On 12/24/20 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Brew City Towing, located at 4030 W. Douglas Av., for a threat complaint. Investigation revealed a citizen complained that an employee on scene made verbal and bodily threats toward a citizen, causing the citizen to fear for their safety. This report is being submitted by Officer Carlos Felix assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Day Shift.

On January 11, 2022 I had a phone conversation with Nadia Adams whom called LIU after removing her vehicle form the Brew City Tow lot, located at 4030 W. Douglas Av. Adams stated, she parked her vehicle in the Judy's Red Hot parking lot located at 4812 W. Lisbon Av. and went to the salon across the street. When Adams returned she discovered her car had been towed by Brew City. Adams went to retrieve her car from the tow lot two hours later and was charged the following \$398.00. She stated that Brew City charged the following fees \$150.00 tow, \$125.00 Special equipment, \$25.00 Storage, \$30.00 City, and \$18.00 tax. I asked her if there were "No parking" signs posted in the parking lot and she stated, she did not recall. I asked her if anyone at Brew City explained all of the fees or showed her pictures of her car illegally parked and she stated, no. I had Adams email me a copy of the invoice she received from Brew City.

When I received the invoice I was able to make out that a tow was billed from 4806 W. Lisbon Av. and the charges Adams explained. Some items were hard to make out on the invoice due to the light transfer of writing on the paper. The time appeared to be 1406, date of 1/5, and tow number 220104. There was no driver or complainant information listed on the invoice. At the bottom of the invoice someone wrote in "No permission to park there".

On January 12, 2022 at 12:24Pm I followed up with this complaint at 4030 W. Douglas Av. Brew City Towing and Recovery. Upon entering the business I spoke to female at the front window and requested to speak with an owner or manager, which she informed he was there. I advised her of my follow up regarding Adams' complaint, and would like to talk the owner or manager about that issues and the company's best practice when conducting tows. The female stated she did not work for Brew City and was only there because the regular employee was out with COVID. I asked if she was the person whom released Adams' vehicle and she stated, no.

l asked when would there be an owner or manger be around so I could discuss that transaction and other best practice items. The female was evasive and continued to state she did not work there. She stated the manager is in and out daily and asked if I would like her to call him. I advised her to have the manager call me and asked her name, which she identified herself as Stacy. I wrote her name down and asked her last name and stated Davis. As I asked her date of birth she became upset and stated that was not her real name. She identified herself as Stefanie Powell (08/24/1980). A check on Etime confirmed her identification.

An employee contacted the manager via phone and handed it to me. A male whom identified himself over the phone as Jaime Blas the manager asked if he could help me. I informed Blas of the follow up and I would like to talk to him about their business' best practices but he continued to be evasive. Blas informed me that he was out checking on contracts and could not meet me. I advised him that I would

follow up with him at a later date.

I relocated to 4812 W. Lisbon Av. (Judy's Red Hots), which is also 4806 W. Lisbon Av. the location of the tow. I observed the "No Parking" signs posted throughout the lot and some with a business name for Apys Tow (397-5741). I spoke to the manager who identified himself as Akbur Adnan. Adnan did confirm that he has an open complaint with Brew City tows regarding non-customers parking in the lot.

As of January 18th I am still waiting to follow up with Blas, but found out that District Four conducted a search warrant at the property regarding a stolen vehicle.

On January 18, 2022 at 1:00PM I called Adams and left her a voice message.

Initial Incident (Stolen Vehicle)

On September 7th, 2021, John PFAFF (W/M, 10/03/60) reported his vehicle stolen. The vehicle is a 2018 white convertible two door Mercedes A43, vin of WDDWK6EB1JF759990 (registered FL Auto plate of IP18SY). PFAFF stated while at the address of 3216 W Lake St, which is located in Minneapolis, MN, he dropped the vehicle keys outside of the business. PFAFF stated when he realized he dropped his keys, he went back outside but noticed that his vehicle had been stolen. This was reported under Minneapolis PD case number 21-204-135.

On Thursday, January 6, 2022, Progressive Insurance Company agent Chris, called for police stating the company, Brew City Towing (4030 W Douglas Ave) had the above listed stolen vehicle but was refusing the company (Progressive Insurance) access to the vehicle, (CAD 22-006-1158). A squad responded to investigate the incident but the business was close so they were unable to investigate the incident.

Initial Contact with 4030 W Douglas Ave

On Friday, January 7, 2022, Chris contact MPD regarding a stolen vehicle and Squad 4141 (myself) responded to 4030 W Douglas attempting to locate the vehicle. While on scene on Friday, January 7, 2022, I spoke with Jamie J BLAS (w/m 1/7/77), who stated he was the owner of the business, Brew City Tow Lot. BLAS advised me that on 10/13/21 his company towed the vehicle form a private tow lot, and before his company tows any vehicle they called Department of Public Works Tow Desk to see if the vehicle has been listed as stolen. He stated on 10/13/21 his driver was informed the vehicle was not stolen; they towed the vehicle to their lot at 4030 W Douglas Ave. While on scene I did not located the vehicle and did not received an answer on the phone for Chris.

Follow up was later conducted with Chris via phone and he informed officers of the ongoing issue that his company were being denied access to the vehicle.

Locating the vehicle

On Monday, January 17, 2022 after speaking with the Progressive Agent, Squad 4234 (P.O. Riley OCONOR and I) responded back to the location (4030 W Douglas Ave) and located the vehicle. The vehicle is a 2018 white convertible two door Mercedes A43, with the vin of WDDWK6EB1JF759990 (registered FL Auto plate of IP18SY, but the plates were not on the vehicle), the license plates attached to the vehicle are AHW8886.

BLAS was on scene along with his lot worker, Stefanie L. POWELL (w/f 8/24/80).

Interview of BLAS from 1/17/22

BLAS stated on October 13, 2021 his business towed the vehicle, and was not advised that the vehicle was stolen. I then advised BLAS that the vehicle was reported stolen on 9/7/21 from Minneapolis and is currently still in the system as stolen. He stated since he was not advised that the vehicle was stolen, he sent a certified letter to PFAFF (registered owner during the initial tow session) regarding the stolen vehicle. He stated the certified letter advised PFAFF that he had his vehicle on the lot and within 30 day if he do not arrive to retrieve the vehicle PFAFF will then forfeit his rights to owning the vehicle. He then stated he did not hear anything from PFAFF.

BLAS stated in the first week of January he received a phone call from Progressive Insurance Company and they asked him if they could come and retrieve the vehicle from him, and he then replied and informed them that they could not get the vehicle back because it was sitting on his lot for over 30 days.

Upon arrival I informed BLAS and POWELL that the vehicle was listed as stolen and that we (Squad 4234) were on scene to retrieve the stolen vehicle. I conducted a check with e-time and NCIC which revealed the vehicle (White Mercedes-Benz) was stolen, and printed the information from my marked squad car (Vehicle 66) and showed the information to BLAS. I also contacted Minneapolis Police and spoke with P.O. Scott KAISER (from the 5th Precinct) who confirmed the vehicle was still stolen, and the Minneapolis PD Case Number was 21-204-135. I then informed BLAS the vehicle was stolen and we (Squad 4234) needed to recover/tow it off of his lot.

While on scene BLAS contacted DPW and spoke with desk worker "PAT" who informed him the vehicle was not stolen. I then spoke with "PAT' and informed him that the vehicle was stolen and I was then informed there could be an issue with DPW System regarding E-time. BLAS then contacted his attorney while officers were on scene, then BLAS indicated that his attorney told him not give up the vehicle. I then contacted squad 4213 (SGT Julian NUNEZ), who shortly after arrived on scene with another printed copy of the E-time and NCIC stolen vehicle print off.

While on scene P.O. RAINEY and Sgt. Nunez (Squad 415) both then showed BLAS multiple times the printed form, stating that the vehicle was still listed as being stolen and even matched the vin off of the papers to the vin on the vehicle that was parked on the lot.

The vehicle was secured within a fenced lot on the premises, that had one vehicle blocking the front and other vehicle on the side. Officers informed BLAS that they would need to gain access to the lot to

retrieve the stolen vehicle, and informed BLAS that we would need the vehicle that was blocking the entrance gate moved along with the vehicle that was blocking the front of the vehicle removed.

BLAS then stated that he would not move any of the vehicle because he did not have keys, but BLAS has multiple working tow trucks on his lot. BLAS was then informed that officers would have a tow truck arrive on scene to remove the vehicle, and BLAS still refused to move the vehicles. Officers informed BLAS that a search warrant would be applied for in order to gain entry onto the premise to remove the vehicle if he refused to provide the vehicle.

While trying to gain compliance from BLAS departed from the premise and obstructed officers by refusing to turn over the stolen vehicle to officers. Squad 4234 then called for a City of Milwaukee Tow and upon the tow arrival POWELL was still on scene. POWELL initially refused to move the vehicle (black Honda sedan) that was blocking the entry way. POWELL finally moved the vehicle out of the way and then was asked to move the other vehicle that was blocking the stolen vehicle. POWELL became very irate and stated she will no longer stay on scene to offer her services to help officers regarding this investigation. POWELL then began to state multiple times that she did not work for the company. POWELL then called BLAS while officers were on scene and BLAS then informed POWELL to block the front entrance way with their black Honda, and lock the gate. I then informed POWELL that if she did that officers would apply for a search warrant, POWELL advised BLAS (via phone) that we would apply for a search warrant, he still informed her to close and lock the gate. POWELL closed and locked the gate while stating, "I don't work here!" then fled the scene.

A search warrant was approved and executed which finally led to officers removing the vehicle from the premise. MFD Rescue 2, red shift, LT Nicholas POLIAK arrived and assisted officers with gaining entry to the locked fence by cutting off the lock. The vehicle was then towed to the City of Milwaukee Tow Lot under Tow Number 2157590.

I then contact DPW regarding the tow from 10/13/21, and was advised that the vehicle was towed from 2830 N Oakland Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee. The tow number that was used on that day was 2183479 at 12:17 AM.

BLAS is currently out on Parole regarding court case # 1994CF0416. BLAS'S Parole agent was contacted regarding and an order to detain was issued.

On Tuesday, January 18th, 2022 Blas came into the Milwaukee Police Department/District 4 lobby. Blas was subsequently arrested and processed.

During the whole investigation BLAS and his employees were uncooperative, which resulted in officers to apply for and execute a search warrant for the business Brew City Towing.

I also spoke with the owner of the actual building, Robert NACZEK (w/m 2/6/45). NACZEK stated he has owned the building for over 30 years and he rents the space out to BLAS. He stated he has no idea what type of business BLAS runs but he want no parts of the business or this incident.

It should be noted that a check of LIRA revealed that multiple Recycling, Salvaging, or Towing Premises (RSTP) Licenses were granted at the address of 4030 W Douglas Av. Brew City Towing LLC has a license

that expires on 04/12/2023 and the applicant is Nietzche CAMARENO. Jamie BLAS has a RSTP License for the business Apys Cars at the location that was granted on 09/21/2021 but was not issued because he has not met all the requirements per License Division.

Officer Carlos FELIX of LIU conducted follow up and determined that BLAS is an employee of CAMARENO and CAMARENO stated that BLAS' intentions are to get his own licenses and take over the location.

On Friday January 28, 2022 at 9:00AM I followed up at Brew City Towing and Recovery located at 4030 W . Douglass Ave, regarding a stolen car reported to District 4, case number 220170135.

I spoke to Jaime Blas, manager of Brew City Towing. Jaime was aware of a phone conversation I had with Nietzche Jose Camareno-Cirino owner and agent of Brew City towing and Recovery.

Jaime Blas

On January 12,2022 I had a phone conversations with Blas regarding his involvement with the business and he identified himself as the manager of Brew City Towing and Recovery, which he confirmed on this date in person. I advised Jaime that I was following up on a car that was reported stolen and Brew City (namely Blas) refuse to release it to a representative of Progressive Insurance Company, the legal owner. After the Milwaukee Police Department was called to the scene Blas still refuse to release the vehicle.

Blas stated, Progressive Insurance did send a representative from the Insurance Auto Auction (IAA) to recover a 2018 Mercedes Benz that had been towed to their lot on a nonconsensual tow form 2830 N. Oakland Ave., which is the Goodwill lot and one of their clients. The IAA representative informed Blas that the Mercedes had been reported stolen and he was there to recover the car. Blas informed the representative that there was an outstanding bill for tow and storage. Blas stated, Progressive Insurance refused to pay the amount owed for the tow and storage and only wanted to pay what they felt was fair. At no time before this visit was Brew City Tow made aware of the Mercedes being reported stolen. He stated that his driver known as Tito requested a tow number from the City Tow Desk before the vehicle was brought to their lot. Brew City conducted an owner's and Lien check of the vehicle, which did not

reveal the car was stolen. Also the DPW Tow Desk did not confirm the vehicle to be reported stolen. Six days after the vehicle was towed to their lot a certified letter was mailed to the lien holder and register owner.

Diane Galarza

Galarza who identified herself as Blas's mother and the office manager stated, she did send the register owner and the lien holder a certified letters advising of the vehicle being towed and stored. I observed the copies of the post office certified mail receipts that were postmarked and addressed to Daimler Title Company and John Barton Pfaff. A copy of the receipts and other documents are attached to this report. I also observed a copy of the Brew City Tow Receipt dated October 13th, a document on "Apy's Cars" letterhead notifying the car was towed to 4030 W. Douglas Ave. from 2830 W. Oakland Ave. I advised Galarza that one of the documents was on Apy's letterhead and Blas does not have a valid city license to operate as a nonconsensual tow business. Galarza stated it was a mistake.

Nietzche J. Camareno-Cirino

Interjected during the conversation, stating that they did everything the company is required to do, but Blas dealt with incident. He denied knowing that a warrant was drafted and served to enter the property and recover the vehicle. I confirmed with Camareno that Blas is the manager of Brew City and he Camareno is the License Agent. Camareno stated, until Blas buys the contracts from him. I advised Camareno that as the owner/ agent he is responsible for what occurs at the business and should have knowledge of the daily activities. I also informed him that it appears that two business are operating out of the same location, which he denied and replied once again that Blas needs to buy him out first. I pointed out the letter that was mailed out with Apy's on the heading.

Representative from Progressive Insurance

On January 28, 2022 I received an email from Christopher Grubb from Progressive Insurance who I was in contact with regarding the tow of this vehicle.

Grubb sent me copies of documents he received from a company he identified as Apy's Towing and an email documenting his interactions with the tow company.

Rosenow stated that a previous manager of the Goodwill store located at 2830 N Oakland Ave. entered into a verbal contract with Apy's Towing and recovery back around August 2021. Rosenow stated in her office there is an unsigned towing contract for Apy's towing. Rosenow had no more information on any other towing agreement besides the one with Apy's. She stated, the only towing company she has knowledge that is allowed to tow from the Goodwill lot is the company that has signage posted in the lot and identified as Apy's towing. I advised her that I did see the signs posted on the fence and also could see them on Google Maps.

On February 8, 2022 at 1:20PM a had a phone conversation with Blas and advised him that I would be issuing a citation for conducting tows and operating without a City License. I asked if he would like to meet me at his shop or should I mail it. Blas stated that mailing it would be fine and requested an email copy. I advised Blas to call me if he does not receive a hard copy within a few days.



On Saturday February 4, 2023, at 2:15 pm, P.O. Kevin HANSEN and I were dispatched to 4030 W. Douglas Av. (Brew City Towing) for a Landlord Trouble complaint.

Upon arrival I spoke to Joshua J RUGGLES (W/M, 7/27/80) who stated that he allowed to rent the garage as well as a portion of the lot. He stated that he has been renting there for approximately 5 months and does not have any type of written agreement or lease.

RUGGLES stated that BLAS and GALARZA stated that he owes them \$1,000. He stated that he is agreeing to pack up his stuff and leave but he is currently unable to pay them.

I spoke to BLAS who stated that RUGGLES has been renting out space in the garage but has no rights to the lot. BLAS stated that they would refuse to allow RUGGLES to retrieve the vehicle that he has parked on the lot until he gets paid.

RUGGLES does have three vehicles parked on the back lot. One of the vehicles belongs to his fiancé and the other two are customers of his and they were vehicles that he was working on.

BLAS and GALARZA both continued to deny RUGGLES to retrieve his vehicle stating that they need to be registered vehicle and the owners need to be present to remove the vehicle.

RUGGLES did have his fiancé arrive who did have the title with her information written to the back of the title. BLAS and GALARZA still continued to deny RUGGLES from retrieving his vehicles.

After speaking with my SGT and determining that it was a crime to BLAS and GALARZA to retain RUGGLES property I advised BLAS and GALARZA that arrests may be made due to them refusing to release RUGGLES' property BLAS replied to me stating that he can have his car because I (P.O. LEIDY) was bullying him. I advised him that I was not attempting to bully him and that this is the probable outcome if they refuse to release his vehicle.

GALARZA did open up the gate and moved the vehicle which was blocking the gate allowing RUGGLES

You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
