There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney.

If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

6. On 03/10/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a Property Damage complaint at McCarty Park

Sports Pub & Grill (6828 West Oklahoma Avenue). Investigation revealed a patron was asked to leave the business after creating a disturbance. On his way out, this patron punched a sliding window causing approximately \$50.00 in damage to the building. This patron was cited.

7. On 04/15/2015 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, was able to purchase two Miller High Life's from the bartender, Michelle Marx, at McCarty Park (6828 West Oklahoma Avenue). The bartender was informed about the Respect 21 Program.

ADDITION	AL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

This report is written by Police officer Michael WARD, District 6 Community Liaison Office.

This location is still set up as a bar. Renovations have not started at this point for future business.

Discussion regarding future layout of the business was had. Attached are the future plans and layout of the business provided by the owner.

The owner is planning on having 4 future exterior cameras covering the patio, parking lot, rear and sides of building. The owner is not sure on the amount of interior cameras at this time, but will have cameras capturing the main entrance and exit, and checkout counter area. The owner

stated the cameras will be color, digital, and store footage for at least 7 days. Only owners and management would have access to cameras.

There will be future windows installed around the building, which will be located on the south and east side of the building. These new windows will give the location clear sight lines in and out of the building. The location will also have a patio for guest to sit outside and enjoy a cup of coffee. A discussion was had regarding signage on the windows and the importance of clear sight lines. The owner advised me that he will have limited signage on the windows when opening.

A discussion regarding additional direct lighting on the exterior of the building was had. This would enhance the surveillance and illuminate the parking lot on the east side of the building. Lighting was not observed during the hours of darkness.

A discussion regarding having a limited supply of sandwich bags, chore boy, blunt wraps, and other items that could be used for drug was had. The owner understands these items can be used for drug use and our concerns of having an overabundance of these items. The owner stated he will not be selling scales at the location.

The owner stated the sales counter will be enclosed, and not accessible to customers. The owner stated he will most likely have the safe located behind the counter. The owner was not able to answer what type of safe he would have at the time of the inspection. We did discuss a drop safe, and securing the safe to the floor or making sure it weighed enough so it would not be easily moved.

The location currently has a large basement that is accessible to customers. The owner stated in the future plans the stairwell will be walled off and the basement will be used for storage.

This concludes my additional notes for this location.




City Concentration Map for 6828 W Oklahoma Ave

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 7/18/2023 at 9:00 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimonv.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
