5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The redevelopment of the Building 29 project historic renovation project was previously approved by HPC in 2015. Masonry restoration work commenced thereafter and the building opened for business in August 2016 as a student housing facility d/b/a Eleven25 at Pabst.

The Applicant is seeking COA approval to complete selective tuckpointing and selective window sill replacements on the east facade and hidden east facade of the building as described herein.


RD Woods will be hired to complete the repairs. RD Woods was the same mason that completed the original building restoration back in 2015/2016.

The locations of the anticipated tuckpointing / window sill replacements are detailed on the elevations attached as Exhibit A and B. The areas being addressed are due to deterioration since the 2015/2016 restoration.

The mortar to be used for tuckpointing is Type O mortar in color Frost 3510. This is the same color and mortar type as previously used in the 2015/2016 restoration. The material cut sheet is attached as Exhibit C.

The stone to be used for the window sill replacements will be either: (i) Scioto, color buff, with a sandblast finish for the 1889 building portion, or (ii) Bedford, color buff with a honed finish for the 1911 building portion. This is the same stone color, type and finish as previously used in the 2015/2016 restoration. The stone schedule is attached as Exhibit D and an elevation photo with the existing material is attached as Exhibit E.
