## Good AFternoon Chris,

DNS was included in several budget amendments during the 2023 budget process that require information be reported back to the F&P committee.

Amendment #28 and file #221285 directed DNS to survey developers and residents about their Development Center experiences. Due to vacancies and absences in the management structure of the Development center, the implementation was delayed longer than we would have liked. However, current data as well as a visual representation of how DNS is gathering the data is attached for the committee's review. A final report will be provided at year's end with all cumulative data.

Amendment #31 and file #2212869 directed DNS to prioritize spending at least \$400,000 of demolition funding on concentrated blight areas. The demolition data supporting this directive is attached.
