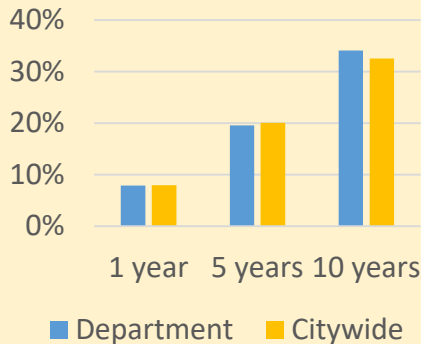

**Staffing Vacancies**

There are currently 1,822 authorized sworn law enforcement positions, with 1,639 filled and 192 vacancies.

There are 786 authorized civilian positions, with 370 filled and 417 vacancies.

Total authorized positions are 2,608, with 2,009 filled and 599 vacancies.

167 911 Dispatchers are being transferred to the Dept. of Emergency Communications.

The 2024 Proposed Budget funds the maximum number of annual classes (3) each at the maximum level of recruits per class (65). Factoring in expected attrition, the average sworn strength is estimated to reach 1,645, an increase of 15 (1%) more than 2023 funded positions.

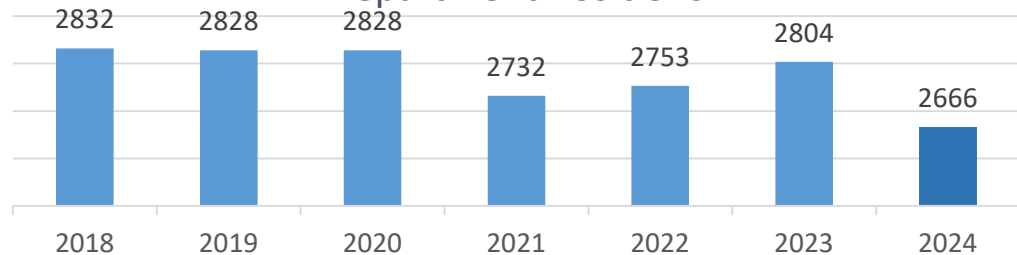

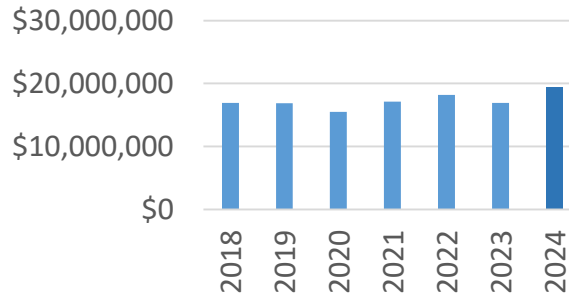

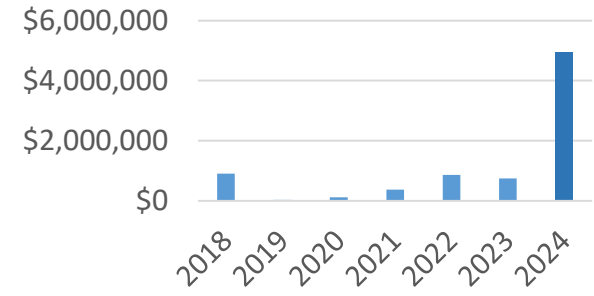

The Proposed Budget estimates that \$4,835,000 total revenue will be generated by the department, a decrease of \$60,500 (1.3%) from the 2023 Adopted Budget.

The department anticipates the estimated revenue will come from Charges for Services, primarily through contract reimbursed overtime for the Brewers and the Bucks.

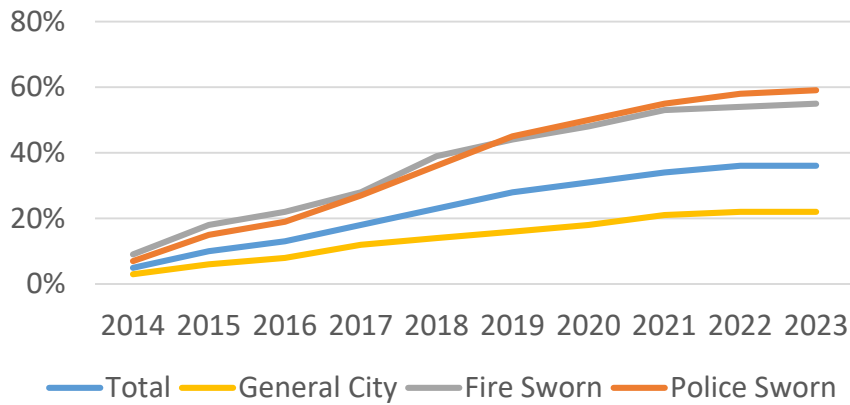
