Dear Mr. Pietsch:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$285.00, in regards to vehicle damage allegedly sustained as a result of colliding with a pothole in the area of 10855 West Park Place on March 28th, 2023.

Wisconsin municipalities have discretionary immunity from liability for any damage that is due to a defect in a sidewalk or street. The City takes any report of defective streets or sidewalks seriously and upon notice of any defect, the Department of Public Works sends a crew to investigate and/or patch, repair or barricade the hazard. Under discretionary immunity, the City is generally not liable for damages.

In checking their records, the City's Infrastructure section found that there were five calls into the call center regarding potholes in the area of 10855 West Park Place between January 8, 2023 and March 28, 2023. Because there were seven snow events between DPW's first notice on February 28, 2023 and the eventual repair on March 30, 2023, staff was diverted to snow removal operations, and their response was delayed.

It is our view that the City was not negligent in this case, and therefore we are not liable for damages. As such, we are denying your claim. If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk,


