Executive Director Emilio De Torre	My name is Emilio De Torre. I am the Executive Director of the Milwaukee Turners at Turner Hall. We have been on the same block since 1855. At this location since 1882.
Operations	We've had limited time to look at the proposed new construction plans for the new FPC Live Nation venue since they texted me on October 3rd.
Manager Krissie Fung	We have a couple of concerns we would like the CPC to help us address.

The Safety Analysis and Mitigation Strategy that is attached is generic and doesn't discuss how pedestrian and vehicular traffic will be efficiently directed during days when the Panther Arena, Miller, Fiserv, WCD, Turner Hall and the new venue have events simultaneously. We have great concerns over how hundreds of patrons to the ballroom, Turning Tables Tavern, and the gymnasium will be able to safely access our facility during these times. We work closely with Tenor High School one block south of us, and Golda Meier a few blocks north of us and students and staff frequently walk to our building as well. Given that I just attended a meeting with the Milwaukee Police Department Friday morning where they were asking local businesses to link their camera systems to the MPD system so they could more easily monitor

crime due to staffing shortages, I'm doubly certain that this Safety Plan doesn't address the actual needs surrounding safety, vehicle and pedestrian flow. I have seen working animated models of crowd flow from groups such as Coliseum GSVA and Maptelligent, and we would feel better for a project of this scale if there were actual flow patterns shown to the city and us to illustrate what they propose during high usage times. Right now it just says FPC will work with various partners. The Milwaukee Turners would like to see specific plans addressing security, pedestrian and vehicle flow before we can form an opinion on the proposed changes to this venue.
