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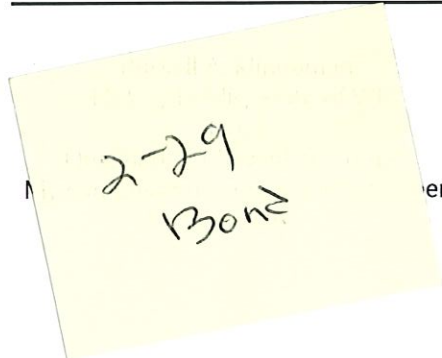

ordinance that was introduced at
the November 21, 2023 meeting of
the Milwaukee Common Council,
the essence of which is as follows:

A substitute ordinance relating to
the change in zoning from Parks,
PK, to Industrial Light, IL1, for the
northeast portion of 6141 North
Hopkins Street and the change
in zoning from Industrial Light,
IL1, to Parks, PK for the property
located at 6301-ADJ North 55th
Street, located on the west side
of North Hopkins Street, south of
West Woolworth Avenue, in the 1st
Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council
of the City of Milwaukee ("Common
Council"), do ordain as follows:

Part 1. That is added to the Mil-
waukee Code of Ordinances a new
section to read as follows:

The zoning map is amended to
change the zoning for the north-
east portion of 6141 North Hopkins
Street, Tax Key No. 157-9998-117,
which is part of Lot 1 of CSM DCD
#3408 from Parks (PK) to Industri-
al Light (IL1). Legal description as
follows:

Part of Lot 1 of CSM 9308 and
lands in the Northeast 1/4 of Sec-
tion 26, Town 8 North, Range 21
East, in the city of Milwaukee, Mil-
waukee County, Wisconsin, bound-
ed and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast
corner of said 1/4 Section, thence
S 00°29'26" E 1336.001 feet;
thence S 88°35'59" W 60.008 feet
to the Southeast corner of Lot 1,
CSM 9308; thence S 88°35'59"
W 243.886 feet along the south
line of said CSM to the point of
beginning of lands to be described;
thence N 52°31'28" W 66.24 feet;
thence 20.728 feet along the arc
of a curve, whose center lies to
the Southwest, whose radius is
30.908 feet, and whose chord
bears N 71°44'10" W 20.34 feet;
thence 89.939 feet along the arc
of a curve whose center lies to the
Northeast, whose radius is 79.500
feet and whose chord bears N
61°25'14" W 78.360 feet; thence
N 31°53'38" W 2.430 feet; thence
41.451 feet along the arc of a curve
whose center lies to the Southwest,
whose radius is 78.500 feet, and
whose chord bears N 46°13'52" W
40.971 feet; N 61°21'30" W 9.784
feet; N 82°10'49" E 197.305 feet;
thence S 05°59'03" W 146.902 feet
to the point of beginning.

And the zoning map is amended
to change the zoning for 6301-ADJ
North 55th Street, Tax Key No.
156-9996-161 from Industrial Light
(IL1) to Parks (PK).
