- First Black Catholic congregation
- Founded 1909

ST BEN

- In original building from 1923
- Significant for Education, Medicine and Black History

National Register

- The National Register of Historic Places is the official list of the Nation's historic places worthy of preservation. Authorized by the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966. It is part of a national program to coordinate and support public and private efforts to identify, evaluate, and protect America's historic and archeological resources.
- Imposes no restrictions on changes or use of property unless seeking government assistance or a federal permit.
- Eligibility for preservation grants
