There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. - 1. On 10/12/23 at 5:05p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon at 627 E. Capitol Dr. On arrival officers interviewed an employee, who was bleeding from the nose. The employee stated a known subject came in and pistol whipped them. The employee refused medical treatment and did not want to be a victim. Both the employee and manager were uncooperative with the investigation.
- 2. On 02/10/24 at 5:07a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Burglary at 627 E. Capitol Dr. Investigation revealed two suspects gained entry to the locked business via breaking glass on a exterior door. Both suspects then entered the establishment and took US Currency, before fleeing. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the Keyonte F BROWN B/M DOB 05/26/2001 who is currently an employee at Wendy's. I observed BROWN to be bleeding from his nose. I asked BROWN if he needed medical treatment and he refused. I attempted to interview BROWN regarding the incident that had occurred; BROWN was uncooperative. BROWN stated that a male was supposed to give him money and that the subject left the restaurant and later returned with another male who then pistol whipped him with a gun. BROWN stated that he was not afraid of the male subject who had the gun. BROWN stated that he did not want to be a victim and did not want to press charges regarding the incident.

I spoke to the manager identified as Marenda S GLADNEY B/F DOB 12/07/1985 who did not provide any information regarding the incident. GLADNEY did not provide any video surveillance regarding the incident.

GLADNEY and BROWN were uncooperative during the investigation

BROWN was provided a PD-33 regarding.

On Saturday, February 10th, 2024, I was assigned to Squad 5340, I was operating a marked black and white MPD Squad Car (Car #502), which was equipped with the Axon in car camera system which was not activated during this investigation. My partner, P.O. Robert ROEMBKE (driver) and I (passenger) were in full MPD uniforms with badges and nameplates affixed to our outermost garments. P.O. ROEMBKE and I were equipped with body worn cameras which were activated during portions of this investigation. I was dispatched to 627 E Capitol Dr, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin regarding a Burglary complaint.

Upon arrival, we made contact with a subject identified as Rolando MALDONADO ACOSTA (W/M, 01-14-79) who stated that he is the District Manager at Wendy's, located at 627 E. Capitol Dr in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. MALDONADO stated (2) two unknown actor (s) intentionally and without consent broke the glass door on the east side of the building, entered the building and deprived the business of approximately \$300.00 in U.S. Currency in unknown denominations at the time of the incident.

Interview of Rolando MALDONADO ACOSTA (W/M, 01-14-79)

MALDONADO said that at approximately 5:07am on Saturday, February 10th, 2024, two (2) unknown subjects approached the building at 627 E. Capitol Dr, located in the City and County of Milwaukee from the east side of the building. Suspect #1 approached the exterior glass door on the east side of the building and rammed the bottom of the glass with her shoulder, which shattered the glass to make entry into the locked establishment.

MALDONADO said Suspect #2 could be observed standing near the sidewalk in front of the business as a lookout while Suspect #1 made entry to the business. MALDONADO had video surveillance video when we arrived on scene which depicts the movements of both suspects as they approach, enter and exit the business. Both suspect make entry to the business and make there way to the kitchen area near the registers in the rear of the business.

Both suspects are observed inside the business and head directly for the kitchen area near the rear of the business. Both suspects are observed kicking at the bottom of an office door that appears to be locked. Both suspects enter the office area from going through the bottom of the broken door and are seen depriving the business of U.S. Currency in the cash register drawers. Both suspects then exit the office and are observed exiting the emergency door near the rear of the business at approximately 5:09am on 02-10-24.

The suspects flee the area after dropping money on the ground and then pick it all up and run westbound into the U-haul car lot to the west of the location.

Suspect Descriptions

- Suspect #1 Black/Unknown Sex, LSW Silver Jacket W/ Hood, Black Pants, Black Mask, White Fanny Pack, Black Shoes and Black Gloves
- Suspect #2 Unknown Race/Unknown Sex, LSW Black Jacket W/ Hood, Black Pants, Red Mask, Tan Yeezy Slides and White Glove (Right Hand) and Blue Glove (Left Hand).

MALDONADO stated that the Manager informed them that they didn't have access to the safe to drop the money for the night and they left the money in the office after closing. MALDONADO

stated Wendy's closed at 1:30am and the manager identified as Tomeshia M. BENDER (B/F, 01-31-85) was the last person at the restaurant. MALDONADO stated BENDER has worked at that location for approximately six (6) months and has been with the company for approximately one (1) year.

Additional Information.

I entered an incident notification in regarding and contact Lt. NORBERG to see if detectives would be responding and she stated it would be the Districts to investigate.

PO ROEMBKE took 16 photos at 7:30am of the scene with his MPD issued camera and later uploaded them to Evidence.com

I issued MALDONADO a PV-17 (green) and Community Contact Card regarding. I sent MALDONADO a link to upload the video surveillance captured from the incident to Evidence.com which depicted the incident in detail.

Both suspects were taken into custody because of the help from MALDONADO with supply MPD with surveillance footage from Wendy's on 02-10-24.

Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
