Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/31/2011 the applicant, using the name Jihad Haddad, was charged in Milwaukee county with Place/Transport Loaded Firearm/Vehicle.

2. On 09/24/2015 Officers went to Center Street Market, 4630 W. Center St. for a licensed premises check. The applicant was not on scene and the clerk, Mohammad ALTARAWI, did not have a Class D Operators license. The applicant was issued a citation for Responsible Person on Premises Required.

3. On 09/27/2015 Officers went to Center Street Market, 4630 W. Center St. for a licensed premises check. The applicant was not on scene and the clerk, Mohammad ALTARAWI, did not have a Class D Operators license. The applicant returned while officers were on scene and stated he had to leave to pick up his kids. The applicant was issued a citation for Responsible Person on Premises Required.

4. On 10/01/2016 a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a 2 pack of Swisher Sweet cigars from the clerk at Center Street Foods, 4630 W. Center St. The clerk denied the sale but was the only clerk in the store. The applicant was mailed a MARTS letter.

5. The applicant did register for MART regarding Item #4 but failed a mystery shopper and was issued a citation for the original incident.

6. On 06/17/2018 officers were dispatched to 4630 W. Center St to investigate a Strong Armed Robbery. The investigation revealed that a young male threw a water balloon in the direction of the suspect. Later in the day the suspect saw the victim and slapped him. The victim then began hitting the suspect. Neither party wanted to prosecute and the incident was advised.

- 7. On 08/25/2018 a 16 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative, was able to purchase a Mango cigarillo from the cashier at Center Street foods, 4630 W. Center St. The clerk was identified as Mohammad ALTARAWI and he admitted the sale but could not state why he did not ask for ID. The applicant was mailed a MARTS enrollment letter.
- 8. On 10/01/2018 officers were dispatched to Center Street Market, 4630 W. Center St, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. When the officers arrived they saw a customer arguing with and employee. They interviewed the employee who stated the customer pulled a knife on him, threatened him and other employees. The customer was arrested for Disorderly Conduct.

9. On 06/10/2019 an officer was advised the applicant did enroll in MARTS for the 08/25/2018 violation. The business failed a mystery shopper check on 04/24/2019 and the applicant was issued a citation for the original violation.

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10. On 09/18/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Center St Market, 4630 W. Center St. The caller stated the business was selling single cigarettes and stolen property at the business. The officers spoke with the applicant who was on scene and cooperative. He stated he did sell single cigarettes in the past but no longer does that. The applicant allowed officers to check the business and they found no evidence of the violations.

11. On 04/18/21 at 6:11pm, officers were dispatched to a Shooting at N. 47th and W. Center St. Officers conducted a canvas of the area and found Center Street Market, 4630 W. Center St., had surveillance cameras that captured the incident. The employee was cooperative and provided officers with video footage.

- 12. On 12/16/23 at 1:06p.m., Milwaukee Police were assigned to work Wisconsin WINS, which checks area vendors for age compliant tobacco sales. A youth entered 4630 W Center St., and did purchase tobacco products from the cashier, who was also the agent. The agent apologized for the sale.
- 13. On 12/17/23 at 5:54p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shotspotter at 4630 W Center St. On arrival officers recovered 7 .40 caliber casings on the ground in the parking lot. Investigation revealed the victim was in the store talking to the cashier, when the suspect removed a firearm from the victim's pocket and fled on foot. The victim gave chase, at which time the suspect fired rounds into the air. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

On Saturday, December 16, 2023 at 1:06 PM, Squad 2740 (PO Jacob BLANCO and I) conducted a Business Check at 4630 W Center St, 53210 (Center Street Foods). This premise is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

I was informed by the buy team that the buyer, Cornia M STRONG (B/F 12-11-2007), had entered the above named premise at 12:45 PM and purchased a Black and Mild Cigarillo for approximately \$1.19 from a clerk described as the following:

Italian Male, obese, mature adult, light brown sweater with stripes.

PO BLANCO was able to make contact with a clerk at the counter matching this description. He identified himself as Jay HADDAD (W/M 04-10-1970) and was also the agent. HADDAD was reported by the bily 6433 team to have NOT checked the ID of the buyer. HADDAD apologized if he did indeed sell the product. No security footage was reviewed at the store. PO BLANCO informed HADDAD a citation would be issued.

Cit#J981RGX4FZ was issued to the agent. The tobacco selling license for the agent expires in 03-10-2024.

This Business Premise report is submitted by P.O. Alexander DEY, assigned to District 7.

On Sunday, December 17th, 2023, my partner P.O. Nicholaus WASZAK and I were dispatched to **4630 W** Center St (Corner Store - Center Street Market) for a Shotspotter complaint.

Shotspotter - 5 rounds, Flex ID1027359

On scene, we recovered 7 .40 caliber casings at the corner parking lot/sidewalk area next to the corner store.

During the investigation, we made contact with subject identified as Dwayne HARDWICK (01-12-61). HARDWICK stated that at approximately 3:50 PM, while he was inside the store talking to the cashier, an unknown black male subject dressed in black approached him from behind. HARDWICK stated at the time he was armed with a firearm pocketed at his right pants pocket at which time the suspect removed it. HARDWICK stated that the suspect then fled out the store.

HARDWICK stated that he then exited the store and ran after the suspect. HARDWICK stated that the suspect fired shots in the air and HARDWICK then retreated into the store.

HARDWICK described his firearm as a black .45 caliber handgun, unknown make, model and serial number, that he purchased from an "auction".

HARDWICK is not a convicted felon. HARDWICK does not possess a valid CCW.

There is no surveillance outside the store but P.O. WASZAK stated that there is surveillance inside the store, which depicts the suspect removing a firearm from HARDWICK and running out the store. The video surveillance does depict a second suspect, b/m, dressed in a red sweatshirt accompanying suspect#1. The video surveillance depicts the reported incident and what the employee of the store witnessed.

P.O. WASZAK spoke with employee/cashier of the store, identified as ISSA Z NATOR (m/w 03-23-67). P.O. WASZAK reported that NATOR was cooperative in providing a statement and giving access to the video surveillance.

NATOR stated that he did observe the alleged suspect run outside the store and then immediately after heard gunshots. NATOR did not observe or hear anything else related.

nakala istera NATOR did not provide a time at which the outside video surveillance cameras would be operable. I did observe that there was at least one outside the store, one which was affixed to the siding of building slightly above the entrance which would of captured part of the alleged incident.

The listed licensee of the store, Jay HADDAD (m/w 04-10-70) was not on scene nor contacted.

P.O. WASZAK reported that the licenses of the business were posted inside the store and appeared in accordance. There were no observed violations inside the store at the time of investigation.

Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
