N. 86th St. – W. Silver Spring Dr. to W. Fond Du Lac Ave. (ST211220177) Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (8' width of tree border area), and grading.

W. Medford Ave. – N. 86th St. to N. 87th St. (ST211230133) Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (8' width of tree border area), and grading.

5th Aldermanic District

N. Colonial Dr. – W. Auer Ave. to W. Concordia Ave. (Sponsored by the City of Wauwatosa) (ST211230147) Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (7.5' width of tree border area), and grading.

W. Sarasota Pl. – N. 95th St. to N. 100th St. (Sponsored by the City of Wauwatosa) (ST211070143) Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (8' width of tree border area), and grading.


