There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

2. On 10/01/21 at 9:23pm, Milwaukee Police, along with the State Alcohol and Revenue Agents, conducted a license premise check at 4126 N. Teutonia Avenue. The agent informed the applicant that she could not be operating because her state seller's permit was closed. The applicant told agents that she was taking care of her permit and that if she could stay open for one night because an event had been scheduled that she could not cancel. The agent agreed to allow the applicant to have the event but could not be open until her affairs are in order.

Officers did return the next two nights and the establishment was closed.

- 3. On 10/29/22 at 8:15am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to St. Francis Hospital for a battery complaint. Investigation revealed that a mutual fight happened between cousins, over one of the cousin's girlfriends, in the parking lot at 4126 N. Teutonia Avenue. Security helped break up the fight and one of the parties ended up going to the hospital because of his injuries. The tavern was closed at the time of the investigation and nobody was interviewed from the establishment.
- 4. On 04/19/23 at 10:41pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 4126 N. Teutonia Avenue. No violations were found and the applicant was cooperative.

5. On 08/02/23 at 1:55a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Spot Shotter at 4126 N. Teutonia Ave. Officers recovered casings on W. Atkinson Ave., and did not observe any vehicles or houses struck by gunfire. Officers spoke to security at the business who stated they heard the gunfire coming from Atkinson and patrons that were on the patio ran when they heard the gunfire. Officers were advised there was video surveillance, however, the owner stated they were unable to give offices access.

- 6. On 08/16/23 at 3:14a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with a Gun at 4126 N. Teutonia Av. Officers were advised by the owner a patron was causing a disturbance and removed from the business. The patron then began to strike the building with their car and attempted to hit the owner. The owner stated there is video surveillance that may have captured the incident, however, they did not have the password at the moment. The suspect was arrested on scene.
- 7. On 11/24/23 at 1:42a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Spot Shotter that was later determined to be a shooting at 4126 N. Teutonia Ave. Officers located 4 spent casings in the parking lot of the establishment. Investigation revealed there were two victims who were conveyed to two separate hospitals. Officers interviewed one of the victims who was a security guard for the establishment. The security guard stated they recovered a firearm on a patron that was attempting to gain entry to the establishment and denied entry, at which time the patron fired shots, striking the security guard and another victim. The owner was on scene and was advised by patrons of the incident and conveyed their employee to a local hospital. The owner was cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance, however, it was discovered that it was not recording and was livestream only. (2 reports)


- > The building was vacant and under construction. The interior of building was completely empty and not equipped as a tavern setting. The business was projected to open in the year 2025.



Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.




