There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/07/22 at 10:30a.m., Milwaukee Police held a meeting with the agent of Vieux (1619 S. 1st). This meeting was to discuss the plan of operation and the business relationship between the former licensee/property owner. The agent stated until they are able to book more events, they have had to operate as a traditional tavern. The agent further stated the former licensee/owner of building was observed in the building because they were helping with the sound system. The agent went on to state they were interested in hosting a meeting with neighbors and has full access to video surveillance. They also do not allow patrons to use Scrub A Dub parking lot.
2. On 01/22/23 at 2:49a.m., Milwaukee Police were on patron in the area of 1619 S. 1st., when they observed an abundance of vehicles in the area, as well as foot traffic. The officers then observed two subjects knock on the front door and were allowed entry. The officers conducted a License Premise Check, and it was determined the subjects were employees. After leaving the tavern officers were approached by subjects regarding a battery. A subject advised the officer a drink was thrown at them and security did nothing. A suspect was ultimately taken into custody for Resist/Obstruct, Battery and Disorderly Conduct.

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3. On 12/24/23 at 2:32a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1619 S. 1st St. On arrival officers noted it was after hours and observed patrons attempting to enter. Upon entrance, officers observed at least 12 patrons being ushered out of rear door to the business.

The officer spoke to the manager who stated they were aware it was past closing time and they were having problems removing patrons, however, they would work to avoid this issue in the future. The manager stated they have 4 security guards and approximately 12 security cameras.

4. On 07/27/24, Milwaukee Police were conducting Underage Tavern Enforcement utilizing an underage Police Aide and a Plain Clothes Officer. At 12:27a.m., the Police Aide and Officer entered 1619 S, 1st St., and were charged \$20 to enter, however, were not asked for ID. The Police Aide ordered two bottles of beer and were charged \$11 from the bartender. Uniformed officers confronted the manager who stated they did not want MPD to enter as they felt it would scare the patrons away. The manager left to obtain the bartenders information and when they returned the officer advised they need to visually see and identify the bartender, however, the manager refused to allow the officers in. A citation was issued to the agent.

This report was typed by P.O. Antwan POWELL, assigned to District 2, Late Power squad 2425/

On Sunday, December 24, 2023 at approximately 2:32AM squad 2425 along with Squad 2410 (Sgt. Stachoviak) and Squad 2445 (P.O, GAMINO and P.O. KOERNER), conducted a tavern check at the location of 1619 S. 1St. (VieuX) which is located in the city and county of Milwaukee, WI.

Upon arrival, I observed that there were numerous persons inside the bar as well as people attempting to re-enter the bar after hours. It should be noted that the tavern check was conducted at approximately 2:32AM and the normal operating business hours are from 8am to 2am. During the initial walk through of the business I observed approximately 12 people still inside the bar and these people were being hurried out the back of the business as we came into the front of the business.

I spoke to licensed premise manager who was identified as Juan F. RODRIGUEZ (M/W 08-04-1993), who stated that he was aware that it was later in the morning and that they had issues removing some people from the property. RODRIGUEZ stated that he would work to avoid this issue in the future. RODRIGUEZ stated that he currently has 4 security guards working (1 armed) and approximately 12 cameras inside and outside of the business. While inside I observed at least 6 interior cameras. It should be noted that this business was also in possession of several hookah devices stored in the back of the business but I did not see anyone actively participating in hookah.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by PO Dellian MENDEZ-SANTIAGO (PS#028797) assigned to District Two, Late Power shift, in full duty uniform, operating marked MPD Squad 205, and equipped with my department issued body worn camera, which captured this incident.

On Saturday, July 27, 2024, Officers and Police Aides performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. There was one team that was part of this initiative. Our team consisted of an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer monitoring them from a short distance away. The Police Aide for our team was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. Police Aide Victoria A PAGAN (PS#037189) and Police Officer Maritza REYES (PS#036320) were in plainclothes while I, along with Police Officer Jesus RODRIGUEZ JR(PS#029217), Police Officer Justin MERRITT (PS#031959), and Sergeant Jonathan MEJIA-RIVERA were all in full uniform.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments the Police Aide and Police Officer were given instructions. Our plainclothes member of this initiative was advised they were not to produce any identification to any of the establishment. If they were asked to produce identifications they would lie and say they forgot it or didn't have one to attempt to gain entry. It was explained that the Police Aide would order one alcoholic beverage and the plainclothes Officer would order a soda or water. The plainclothes members would provide a detailed description to the uniformed Officers if they were successful in being served an alcoholic beverage. Uniformed Officers would then return to the establishment to confirm the identity of the person who sold the alcoholic beverage to the Police Aide. The uniformed Officers will notify the person that they served a department member who was acting in a plain clothes capacity, and failed our investigation. The uniformed officer would then inform them that they would be receiving a citation and a license premise report would be filed.

On Sunday, July 28, 2024 at approximately 12:27 AM, PO REYES and PA PAGAN arrived at 1619 S 1st St, (The Vieux) in the City and County of Milwaukee, for an undercover underage sell of alcohol, to attempt to purchase alcohol. PA PAGAN entered the restaurant/bar at 12:28 AM, and was not carded by security and let in. PA PAGAN and PO REYES were charged 20 dollars by security staff to get into the establishment without having identifications on them. PA PAGAN ordered two Miller Lite beers, in a bottle, which cost \$11.00. The bartender/Server who served PA PAGAN was described as a W/F, with black hair, short, wearing a black vest and on the heavier side. After a few minutes passed PA PAGAN and PO REYES left the location.

PO MERRITT, PO RODRIGUEZ and I, entered the location, and spoke to the manager who was identified as Juan F. RODRIGUEZ (w/m, 08/04/91). Officers informed RODRIGUEZ his security

staffed allowed an underage person into the establishment and a female server/bartender which was described to him, served the underage person alcohol. RODRIGUEZ became upset and stated he could not believe his security staff would allow this to happen. I explained to RODRIGUEZ, I would need to enter the establishment to identify the female server/bartender who sold the alcohol. RODRIGUEZ stated he did not want officers inside his establishment scaring his crowd away. RODRIGUEZ stated he knew who the bartender was and would obtain the information for me.

RODRIGUEZ returned with the information of the front bartender who he identified as Thalia LAMBRIGHT (w/f, 89/3/02). RODRIGUEZ stated she is the only bartender he has with a black vest, short and on the heavier side. We explained we still would need to see her for ourselves but was not allowed in. Due to this, we were unable to identify for ourselves the server/bartender who served PA Pagan.

RODRIGUEZ was informed a report will have to be filed regarding the violation and a citation would be issued. The owner was not the scene at the time of the violation.

A citation under citation# #M582CZ7RBH for City of Milwaukee ordinance 90-18-1-A-1 (Sale of alcohol to underage person) will be issued with a future court date.

Per the district community partnership unit this location is a designated nuisance premise. *The business is in billing status OR The business submitted an abatement plan which states the business will complete the following items... to eliminate nuisance activity.*

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
