To whom it may concern,

I am writing to strongly oppose granting a liquor license for (Midtown II) and the Class A fermented malt license for One Stop Only, at 3443 W. Wells.

Please do not grant this license. Our neighborhood, and residents are trying so hard to make this neighborhood a safe, and pleasant place to live. We already have so many obstacles.

I hear gunfire regularly, most of the time is coming from the direction of 3443 W Wells. We have loitering, panhandling, theft, public drinking and drunkenness, substantial littering, especially of alcohol containers, public indecency (urination etc.), breaking, and violence.

I have personally have called in shots fired over 30 times this year.

In prior years I've been attacked, and robbed. I've caught people urinating in my yard, and the street next to my yard, and even evidence they deficated in my yard. The litter accumulation is disgusting, exhausting, and getting worse. My yard is constantly full of bottles, cans, snack containers, condoms, feminine products, and occasionally I've even found syringes. Violent attacks, such as rape, are getting worse. And regardless of what other reports might say, I'm hearing gunfire happen substantially more often, worse, and closer to my home. We have people playing ridiculously loud music (so loud I can't hear my TV, while sitting right by it), while they are cruising, or parked, doing who knows what, in front of our houses, at all hours. There is prostitution, quite a bit of it, especially on Wells.

A liquor store may seem to not be related to all these problems. The liquor store clearly will contribute substantially to many of them. In my opinion, they will contribute to all of them. By offering a place to loiter, meet up (possibly also for drug deals or prostitution), and acquire substances that impair judgement, I fear and believe with certainty, that it will exacerbate all the issues, I've mentoned above. I fear another liquor store will increase issues substantially, and will be significantly detrimental to our neighborhood.

We don't have enough resources to combat the problems we already have, (neither does law enforcement, and another liquor store will increase their workload also). Please do not saddle our neighborhood, with even more crime, violence, and other despicable behaviors.

Please do not grant the Class A fermented malt license for One Stop Only, at 3443 W. Wells.

To Whom it Concerns,

We are writing to inform of our strong objection and concern for the referenced application of a liquor license of the referenced establishment. We strongly believe that this should not be granted because of the reasons listed below:

- We are a young family with multiple small children who have seen extreme public drunkenness, lewdness and general public misconduct including often violent arguments due to this business and their patrons being inebriated right outside the store and directly in front of our home.

- Our sidewalk and lawn are often littered with empty/ broken bottles and beverage canisters that have clearly been purchased at this establishment as well as the occasional drunk person who

passes out.

- There are many other families with small children within the direct vicinity of these establishments, who can get seriously hurt by openly drunk driving and actions and who will likely feel concern for increased liquor consumption in the area as it seems most patrons will buy and immediately start consuming the current alcoholic beverages in the public sidewalk.

- Large Loltering that spills into the streets and blocks the sidewalk which becomes a safety concern for pedestrians as well as vehicles, and often requests to move are met with misconduct and disregard.

- Cars often stop in the middle of the street to go purchase these items with disregard for any typical

road rules.

- Loud and often dangerous fights and screaming exchanges by the patrons who already seem over

the legal limit of drunkenness to drive.

- These stores are already in proximity to a Veteren's Affairs Home that has members who are clearly dealing with alcoholism and this will only create an easy method for them to continue this and not progress in their recovery. This is an extremely irresponsible move by the city for those people

working to get back on their feet.

- The city has already had to shut down multiple locations in this area that were granted the similar above license, so this will only serve to waste my and other taxpayer dollars and will ultimately have to be shut down as well. It is clear to anyone with some common sense that this establishment will only serve to increase the above complaints to a more drastic and severe level that will put your citizens in danger and serve to be a gathering spot for patrons that have disregard for rules and safety. This WILL end up with someone (hopefully not a child) in our neighborhood getting hurt or worse.

In summary, please use common sense to ensure that our neighborhood increases in safety (not the opposite) for our neighbors and their and our young children on a street corner that is already busy and unsafe.

If this license is granted we will make every effort to report all public violations until it is ultimately removed as we know through history and experience that this will ultimately be the case.

I am a homeowner

Smiles Liquor. Even with owners' measures to keep premises clean, the product being sold attracted customers with many nuisance behaviors, including littering, urinating, loud music from their vehicles, double parking, hanging out in front or nearby. Whatever entity operated at that premise, which has no parking lot, had vehicles that desired to park close to the entrance of the store, resultinting in double parking, doors randomly opening into traffic lanes, horns honking, making u-turns t0 go in the other direction back onto 35th. People randomly cross the street to get to the other side for their parked car or other purpose, rarely crossing at the corner in the walkway or with the lights. 34th Street is a one way going south, thank goodness, that frequently requires drivers to turn at 35th and Wells to proceed east to get to 34th street.

It requires a high level of patient caution to not hit cars pulling out, doors opening into the traffic lane, pedestrians lollygagging to their destination, people yakking to drivers at their car window with their butts protruding dangerously near the moving traffic.

The sales of any type of liquor product has proven to be an attractive nuisance at this location for decades. We do not want this licence granted.

I hope this email finds you well. My name is

approximately named <u>One Stop Only</u>, located at <u>3443 W Wells Street</u>, which has applied for a liquor license. I am writing to express my strong opposition to this application:

In the past, this area has experienced significant issues related to traffic congestion, loitering, and even possible criminal activities, all of which have had a detrimental impact on our street and neighborhood's safety and quality of life. Granting a liquor license to this store would likely exacerbate these problems, and pick up right where it left off the last time we opposed renewing the license for the previous owner.

The increase in traffic associated with a liquor-selling establishment could lead to more accidents and make our streets less safe for pedestrians, especially for the elderly residents and children in the neighborhood. Furthermore, loitering around the store could result in noise disturbances and an unsafe environment, which are serious concerns for those of us who live nearby. (Again the reason we petitioned to revoke renewal of the license for that location previously.)

The potential for criminal activity associated with the sale of alcohol cannot be overstated. Previous incidents in the area have shown that liquor sales at that location attract undesirable behavior, putting residents and our properties at risk.



I urge you to consider the well-being and safety of our neighborhood and deny the liquor license application for this store. Our neighborhood deserves to maintain the progress we've made towards building a safe and peaceful place to live, and allowing this license would undermine those efforts.




### City Concentration Map for 3443 W Wells St




