Your Food Dealer Retail Application as agent for "Power Hour Depot LLC" for "Power Hour Depot" at 4534 W NORTH Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.




City Concentration Map for 4534 W North Ave

To Whom It May Concern,

We have received information that a new liquor store may open at 46th Street and North Avenue, specifically 4534 North Avenue. While we appreciate the idea of new businesses coming into our neighborhood, we are concerned about opening another liquor store in an area where we already have 15+ nearby.

We have been living in this neighborhood for the past eight years and have noticed an increase in the frequency of gunshots. In the first year of living here, gunshots were very rare, but now they have become a common occurrence. Our neighborhood lacks proper police and safety measures, such as foot patrols, bicycle police patrols, or regular car patrols. Unfortunately, there has been an increase in shootings in our community, and the combination of guns and alcohol is never a good one.

We walk around our neighborhood daily and have noticed that the amount of litter in our immediate blocks has increased. The location where this liquor store is supposed to open is particularly bad with discarded small, cheap liquor bottles and broken glass scattered on our sidewalks and streets. It is quite disturbing to see this, and I fear that another liquor store would only contribute to this problem.

We would like to emphasize the need for positive change in our neighborhood. We disapprove of another store with cheap booze entering our community, further degrading our safety and overall neighborly feel.

We object to this establishment by Power Hour Depot opening in our neighborhood.

To whom it may concern,

My neighbor brought to my attention that you have received an application from Power Hour Depot, Power Hour Depot LLC for a Class "A" Liquor and Malt Retailer's license for the property at 4534 W. North Ave. I am writing to express my strong objections to granting such a license for anyone for this property.

My family has lived on the same block of the property in question for over 10 years. During that time, we have worked very hard with our neighbors to create a family friendly culture of safety and security. I believe the presence of a liquor store would greatly compromise the culture we are striving to nurture.

On your Notice of Public Interest Form, it states that objections should address the "adverse impact on the health, safety and welfare of the public and the neighborhood." Numerous studies show that liquor stores do have the propensity to have such an adverse impact. John Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, for example, reported in a study that "Such stores have been shown to be an important component of the social infrastructure that destabilizes communities." Another example is found in a report from The City University of New York. They note that in neighborhoods with a past history of redlining (such as our neighborhood), there is a correlation between the prevalence of liquor stores and violent crime. Researchers noted that such correlations are not limited to New York, but are being reported around the country. The researchers concluded that licensing is one effective way of addressing this problem.

One might argue that we need to bring more thriving businesses into our neighborhood, and that would be true. We do need business—such as groceries, pharmacies, restaurants, etc. that can contribute to the economic well-being of our neighborhood. A liquor store does not do this. As a

recent publication from the Medical College of Wisconsin notes, "Bars and alcohol retailers are sometimes viewed, incorrectly, as drivers of growth and prosperity in some communities."

As a licensing board, you have a lot of power to control the quality of life for our neighborhood. We already have to deal with other negative issues on a regular basis such as slum lord properties and the crime they draw, and have learned that once a property becomes a problem, it is difficult to turn it around because of Milwaukee's lack of enforcement resources. You have a chance to stop a problem before it begins. If the LLC claims that it will be an exception to the kind of studies I have cited—which are only a small sampling of the many that exist, I would ask that you have them prove their case with documented research from authoritative sources; that they prove that they can have a positive impact on the health, safety and welfare of the public and the neighborhood through that kind of a business. There are plenty of commercial properties in the Milwaukee area that are not located in residential neighborhoods and that could give this LLC a place to do its business. Please do not let them do business in our neighborhood at the expense of our well-being.

The proposed malt/liquor license for the address located at 4534 West North

I oppose the approval of this license because this property will be a nuisance to the neighborhood. I have lived here for three years and truly love this area but it is delicate. One unruly house or one selfish business can have negative effects that ripple throughout the community. This proposed store would bring an increase in non residents loitering outside on the corners and in cars, consuming alcohol in the open, in vehicles and in alleyways and improperly disposing of them in said public spaces, leaving the neighborhood to pick up the scattered, broken refuse on a daily basis.

There are more than 20 young children who live on this single block alone and their parents will feel significantly less comfortable having their children on foot in the neighborhood even effecting their daily walks to and from the bus stop.

There is very limited parking on north Ave at this location so cars will park on 46, best case being constant (literally) foundation shaking bass rumble from cars and the increased traffic and speeding down our residential block once customers disembark.

The common council has been considering allowing denial of liquor Licenses in areas with concentrated poverty and elevated crime and this area would fit the criteria for both.

As to the liquor store itself, it is of the upmost importance that the holder of a license be committed to the responsible and safe distribution of their wares. The proposed name for this particular venture is Power Hour Depot, a reference to a drinking game in which as much alcohol is consumed as possible in a short period of time. This should give the committee pause as to the seriousness of the applicants.

While there are some business on north Ave in the area, there is a far greater concentration of residential stock. I believe that lack of business density in the case of an problematic establishment would unfairly put the onus on the residential community in proximity to it.

This is a family and children oriented neighborhood, so a liquor store is not a good fit. Many very positive and transformational changes have occured in this area over the years, and we would like it to keep moving in that direction as challenges still exist.

Here is a snapshot of that area:

1. The Uptown Community Garden (since 2013) at 2321-25 N. 45th St. We already find empty liquor bottles left on the garden site and in the street.

2. In 2016 the city planted an orchard across from the garden that is well cared for.

3. Tricklebee Pay-What-You-Can Cafe at the corner of 45th and North Ave (4424 W. North Ave). brings healthy food, calm positivity and attracts families and children. It's more than a restaurant, they hold outdoor family events in the summer and indoor family events in colder weather.

4. There is a daycare center across the street from Tricklebee Cafe.

5. The SOS Center at 4620 W. North Ave. runs an after school program for children from Hi-Mount School, as well as other family oriented outreach.

6. Wee Care WIC Wisconsin is located next to SOS at 4630 W. North Ave.

7. Fresh Start Learning Center Inc, 4314 W. North Ave. has been in the area for many years. Their focus is "meeting the needs of those who have fallen victim to human trafficking, homelessness, hopelessness, drug addiction, or domestic abuse."

8. Zim Knives,4404 W. North Ave., recently moved their business to this area - the owner is a

craftsman and bladesmith.

9. Wendy's is just across the street from 4534, bringing in many children and families from all over.

10. Many neighborhood adults and children frequent the large convenience store kitty corner from Tricklebee Cafe.

11. Traffic and parking are already a challenge at that corner. Wouldn't be surprised if customers end up parking in the Beauty Supply Store's large parking lot just next door to 4534.

I hope you can see from the above that a liquor store is not a good fit. We need businesses that will calm the area, and bring positivity. This area needs much TLC. Please don't throw a local liquor store into the mix.
