Re: The Moderne: EBE Data through May 5, 2011 and RPP Data through March 31, 2011

Dear Ms. Purvis:

This report addresses the participation of EBE firms and RPP workers on The Moderne project. Developer Barrett Visionary Development, Contractor J.H. Findorff & Son and Coordinator Prism Technical are fully committed to meeting at least 25% EBE participation on the \$29 million adjusted construction budget and utilizing at least 30% RPP workers on the project.

## **EBE Participation**

As has been previously noted, Findorff solicited bids from union EBE firms through email, fax and phone calls. When EBE firms did not bid or win the bids, Findorff has encouraged selected subcontractors to seek out and entertain the use of EBE firms as second tier contractors or suppliers.

We fully expect the project to meet 25% EBE participation of the adjusted construction budget.

As at least 25% of the \$29,127,806 adjusted construction budget will go to EBE firms, EBEs will receive a minimum of \$7,281,951 on the project.

With EBE firms having contracts or purchase orders for over \$6.3 million, the project is well on its way toward meeting the requirement to include \$7.2 million in EBE participation.

Through May 5, 2011, EBE firms had been paid \$ 337,366.30. Comparatively, \$1,902,485.75 had been spent in those areas represented in the adjusted construction budget. Therefore, the project's EBE payment percentage through May 5, 2011 was 17.7%. As many EBEs are slated to begin their work in later stages of the project, this percentage will increase to at least 25% by project conclusion.

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## **RPP Participation**

Through March 31, 2011, total hours on the project were 8,021.5. Of those hours, 2,432 were worked by individuals certified under the City of Milwaukee Residents Preference Program, yielding an RPP percentage of 30.3%. We anticipate the RPP percentage to stay at this level or increase as the project continues.
