1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

Grant funds would be used by the Milwaukee Police Department's National Integrated Ballistic Information Network (NIBIN) team for overtime to address workload associated with analyzing firearms and casings collected on the streets and in firearm-related crimes. Funding would increase the capacity of NIBIN forensic ballistic specialists, crime scene supervisors, forensic investigators, police officers, and support staff to collect, process, and analyze ballistic evidence.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The grant aligns with the goal to reduce crime and enhance quality of life through providing additional resources to support investigative leads when firearm-related incidents occur and firearms are recovered.
