Homicide and Non-fatal Shooting data was obtained from the OMAP Homicide and Shooting database and counts victims for the same time period. Carjacking data was obtained from the OMAP Carjacking database and counts incidents for the same time period.

City wide calls for service data was obtained from the Tiburon Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system for the time period of January 1st, 2015, through February 20, 2024, and from the Hexagon Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system for the time period of February 20th, 2024, through December 31st, 2024, and reflects distinct calls. Tiburon CAD excludes proactive activity, training units and training calls, calls where a primary unit was not assigned, Priority 5 calls, misdials, cancelled calls, DPR, and calls with a disposition type of MFD, LIU, MSCO, and DRU. Hexagon CAD Dispatched calls exclude calls that were not assigned, cancelled calls, proactive activity calls, and 911 abuse calls that resulted in no police response.
