



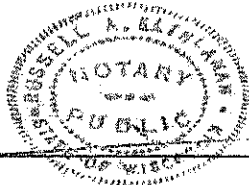

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects Alley between W. Douglas Ave., (ST212160106); N. 105th St. (ST211180172); N. Booth St. (ST211190206); N. Vel R. Phillips Ave. (ST211190207); N. 14th St. (ST211190203); N. 36th St. (ST211190178); N. 38th St. (ST211190193) will be billed after January 1, 2022, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed; and be it

Further Resolved, That project Alley between W. Lloyd St. (ST212010142) will be billed after January 1, 2023, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed;
