There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines: Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

There is a police report.

As far as I understand it: The neighboring apartment building was having Home Depot drop off appliances. The Home Depot truck parked in the gas station. People broke into the Home Depot truck and stole the used appliances while the new ones were being installed – which happened very quickly and almost like someone called folks and told them about the opportunity. The next day, someone broke into the Apartment Building Office, and stole all of the security camera information. The security staff at the gas station were not helpful.

This is thousands of dollars in damages. I do believe Near West Side Partners are aware of this incident as well.

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/10/24 at 8:30a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 1202 W. Highland. Investigation revealed security asked a subject to leave the property and they made a threat to come back and shoot the security officer. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
2. On 07/12/24 at 1:00p.m., Milwaukee Police took a walk-in complaint from a citizen that occurred at 1202 W. Highland. Investigation revealed on 07/12/24 at 1:45a.m., the citizen walked into the business to make a purchase and had a handgun in their pocket. The citizen left, however, remembered they left an item on the counter and returned without their firearm. A security guard then pulled out their firearm and pointed it at the citizen. The officer conducted follow up to identify the security officer, however, they were not on scene and were unable to contact a supervisor of the security company.
3. On 07/31/24 at 2:28a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon at 1202 W. Highland Ave. Investigation revealed a suspect was confronted by security regarding an attempt theft. The suspect made a threat to "pop" the security guard. Once outside the security guard observed the suspect was armed and ordered them to drop their gun. The suspect then left the scene. The business was cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance, however, due to technical difficulties, it was never entered into evidence.com.

4. On 09/02/24 at 6:57a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 1202 W. Highland. Investigation revealed security asked a subject to leave and an altercation took place. The subject threw a cup of coffee at security at which time the security officer strikes the subjects car with their baton, causing the subject to kick the security officer's bumper. The subject then fled the scene. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

5. On 11/06/24 at 3:22a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Reckless Endangering Safety at 1202 W. Highland. Investigation revealed a subject was told to leave due to smoking in the store. The suspect returned with a firearm and fired several shots at the window where the victim was standing. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

This report is written by P.O. Shawn TOMS, assigned to DISTRICT 3 DAY SHIFT, SQUAD 3150.

On 04/10/24, at approximately 0830 hours, squad 3150 was dispatched to 1202 W Highland Av for a threat complaint.

Upon our arrival I observed armed security approach us who was also the caller, Alexander K. MANNAN (W/M 11/09/99).

I spoke to the caller, listed above, AND 414-249-0705. They stated the subject is MO and a criminal and threatened him when he told him to leave the property. MANNAN showed me a cell phone video of the subject on the sidewalk and MANNAN approaching him telling him to leave. MANNAN stated the subject got a on a bus and left the location in an unknown direction. MANNAN stated the subject stated he was going to get his brothers and shoot MANNAN.

Business was as usual and there were no other witnesses outside at the time.

The business was cooperative with the investigation.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. The footage showed the subject near the sidewalk and appeared to be yelling at security then left the scene.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for the threat complaint, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise, but it should be noted that I am not trained in this area, and not part of the Licensed Investigation Unit.

This report is submitted by P.O. Adam GONZALEZ, assigned to District Three, day shift.

On Friday, July 12, 2024, I was assigned to the District Three front desk. At approximately 1:00 pm, Marvin L WASHINGTON (B/M, 11-26-1996) walked into the District Three lobby to report that an individual pointed a firearm at him.

WASHINGTON stated that on Friday, July 12, 2024, he left Mt. Sinai Hospital to go to the BP gas station, located at 1202 W Highland Ave at approximately 1:45 am. While inside the gas station, he stated he had his handgun in his pocket and believes that the only thing that would have been showing was the "butt of the handle." WASHINGTON stated while he was in the gas station neither of the security guards approached him about the handgun or said anything to him about the handgun.

WASHINGTON purchased his items and left the gas station. He stated that he realized very quickly he forgot his cigarettes inside the gas station and went to go retrieve them from inside. Prior to re-entering the gas station, WASHINGTON stated he placed his handgun in his vehicle "out of respect for them."

When WASHINGTON walked back in the gas station, he went to the counter to get his cigarettes, which is when he felt someone "bump" him from behind. He turned around and immediately saw one of the security guards retrieving his handgun from pants pocket.

WASHINGTON described the security guard (suspect) as a dark complected black male, approximately 30 years old, 6'0", weighing approximately 170 lbs with a thin build. He was last seen wearing a black security uniform shirt with body armor over it, black uniform pants, black winter hat and black shoes. Based on cell phone video, which was provided by WASHINGTON the security guard was also equipped with numerous items (example expandable baton) on the outside of his body armor as well as a gun belt equipped with magazines and a black gun around his waist. In front of the body armor, the name "Wisconsin Police Armed Security Officer" is displayed.

WASHINGTON stated that the handgun that the suspect pulled out wasn't the one in his holster but in his pants pocket. He described it as a black handgun with an extended magazine. WASHINGTON stated that the suspect held the gun with two hands and pointed it at him, causing him to fear for his safety. When WASHINGTON observed what was happening he lifted up his shirt to prove he had no handgun on him. Another patron of the gas station started yelling towards the security guard that WASHINGTON was no threat. After pulling up his shirt, WASHINGTON stated that the suspect pulled back the handgun.

WASHINGTON stated that the suspect's coworker was trying to defuse the situation by just asking him to leave the gas station, which he did.

WASHINGTON provided me with cell phone video that he took of the incident. It should be noted that the following is just a summary of the video. To understand the full context of the video, it should be viewed in its entirety. The cell phone video does not show the whole interaction but just after when he pulls his shirt up. I viewed the following on the cell phone video. I observed the suspect asking WASHINGTON to leave the store while holding a black handgun with an extended magazine in his right hand. The suspect has the handgun pulled back to his chin and it appears the gun is pointing in a somewhat downward position at that time. The suspect is stating that WASHINGTON brought a gun in here, referring to the gas station. WASHINGTON then points his cell phone down, which shows that he is holding his shirt up. He is telling the security guards he has no gun on him. Eventually WASHINGTON leaves the gas station. The gas station door then opens up again and WASHINGTON begins to talk with the suspect's coworker about his actions stating that if "he would of been somewhat justified" in pulling out his firearm if at the time he was in the store with his handgun. The suspect is seen telling WASHINGTON that he had his hand on his firearm while he was in the store. WASHINGTON continues to speak with both security guards stating that the moment they noticed he had a handgun "it was there due diligence to enforce the policies of this private property" and ask them to leave or put his firearm in his vehicle and that neither of them asked him to do that. WASHINGTON further tells them that when they noticed he had his handgun "both of you guys stared at me, put your hands on your weapons and did not say anything to me." The cell phone video was uploaded to evidence.com.

On Sunday, July 21, 2024, I conducted follow-up at 1202 W Highland (BP Gas Station) in an attempt to obtain video surveillance of the incident.

I viewed the video surveillance and observed the following. It should be noted that the times are just approximations.

1:44:45- I observed the victim, previously identified as Marvin L WASHINGTON (B/M, 11-26-1996) pull into the parking lot of the gas station.

1:45:25- WASHINGTON enters the BP gas station and goes to the south side of the gas station by the coolers.

1:46:36- WASHINGTON leaves the gas station and walks to his vehicle.

1:47:19- I observe WASHINGTON re-enter the gas station and immediately begins talking with security. It should be noted that the sound of the video surveillance does not work so it is unknown what is being said at this time.

1:48:25- I observe WASHINGTON walk to the door as if he was going to leave but he only opens it before he re-engages the security staff.

1:48:57- I observe the unknown suspect (black male security guard) reach for what appeared to be WASHINGTON's cell phone before pulling out his black hand gun and pointing it at him for approximately 1 second before pulling in back to his chin area.

1:49:26- WASHINGTON leaves the gas station before he re-enters at 1:49:33 and immediately starts to speak with security again.

1:52:15- WASHINGTON finally leaves the gas station and starts walking towards his vehicle.

1:52:45- WASHINGTON pulls out of the parking lot.

The video was downloaded onto a flash drive and later uploaded to evidence.com.

After viewing video surveillance, I observed the other security guard who was working that day outside the gas station. I interviewed the security guard, identified as Alexander R MANNAN (B/M, 11-09-1999) about the incident. MANNAN stated that he observed WASHINGTON walk into the gas station with a handgun in his pocket. He remembers that his partner (suspect 1) asked WASHINGTON to leave the handgun in his vehicle if he can. He stated that when WASHINGTON walked back into the gas station, WASHINGTON began to argue with them stating that he is a firearms instructor and accusing them of being trigger happy. He stated that he did not know why the suspect reached for WASHINGTON but stated that he thinks "he was trying to do a good reaction just in case something happens." MANNAN states he does not know the suspects name. He stated that both of them work for Wisconsin Police Public Safety and gave a phone number to his supervisor of 414-795-2471. I attempted to contact the supervisor at that number in hopes of identifying the suspect but was unable to.

While viewing video surveillance, I observed licenses of the BP Gas Station on the wall located in the office just behind the register area. It should be noted that none of the licenses were the current ones. I checked the City of Milwaukee license database and observed that they have the following licenses.

On Wednesday July 31, 2024 at approximately 02:28A.M., P.O. PROPP and I, (In full duty uniform, equipped with an Axon body worn camera and in a marked squad), were dispatched to 1202 W Highland Av., for a report of a subject with a weapon.

The business located here is a BP gas station (PANTRY 41 #12) , with the main entrance and gas pumps on the North side of the building.

As we arrived on scene, we were greeted by an armed security officer by the name of Cortez D. SCOTT (W/M, 12/24/93). SCOTT stated that he is assigned to that store and that he was assuming his post during the incident.

The incident in short occurred when an unidentified individual (Unknown 1) entered the store. SCOTT stated that Unknown 1 attempted to grab some toilet paper and leave the store without paying. SCOTT stated that he approached this individual and told him that he can't let him take the items without paying. SCOTT stated that Unknown 1 began becoming verbally confrontational and threatened to pop him (referring to shoot him) and told him to come outside. SCOTT stated that he snatched the tissue out of Unknown 1's hands at that time and Unknown 1 began walking out to his car. SCOTT stated that while at Unknown 1's car, Unknown 1 he saw him reaching around in his car and still threatening him by saying, "On my momma I will pop your ass too, I don't care about that badge. I used to work here". SCOTT stated that he was very shook regarding the situation and placed his hand on his gun, but he never took it out of his holster. While doing this, SCOTT stated that he could see that Unknown 1's was armed with a firearm and stated that Unknown 1 said, "Bring your bitch ass outside". SCOTT stated that he drew his firearm at that time and ordered Unknown 1 to drop his gun while the gas station cashier locked the door, and Unknown 1 left after that.

We then spoke to the Cashier Dariq Y. WARRAICH (W/M, 4/1/69) who was reviewing the video footage of the incident. Which showed Unknown 1 entering and leaving the location. However, no footage was ever entered into Evidence.com due to technical difficulties.

Upon our arrival to the location, we did not observe the subject on scene. Officers then made contact with Alexander R MANNAN (W/M 11/09/1999) who called and stated that on the above date he

observed a B/M, thin build, wearing two chain necklaces around his neck, wearing a gray hooded jacket with the Lakers logo on the front, black pants, and gray Nike shoes at his place of work of 1202 W HIGHLAND AVE. MANNAN observed the male inside a vehicle described to be a newer model Nissan Altima (unknown plates, no front plate). MANNAN stated that he went to the male's vehicle because the male was sitting inside of his vehicle from 6:00am-6:30am and due to the subject's vehicle having tinted windows he did not want the male to be sitting inside the vehicle in fear that he would burglarize the store. MANNAN then stated that the male went inside and bought cigarillos "blunts" and then walked out of the store and went back to his vehicle parked at pump 2. MANNAN then stated that the subject then grabbed a cup of coffee from his vehicle and tried to throw it onto him. MANNAN stated that he was able to get out of the way and did not get touched by the coffee.

MANNAN then stated that the male then went up to his vehicle which was a Honda Accord (Wi license plate APJ-9441) and kicked it causing approximately \$200-300 of damage to the driver's side back bumper. MANNAN stated that he had insurance through progressive.

MANNAN then stated that the subject began to make threats stating "bitch" "I'll "beat your ass", MANNAN then stated that the subject then stated that he would shoot the victim, subject then stated "I got something for you" which is when the subject began reaching into his hooded pocket and into his front pants pockets. MANNAN then stated that he took his firearm out of his holster in fear of the suspect grabbing for a firearm. MANNAN then stated that the subject then left going North bound on N 12TH ST.

P.O. GALVAN then collected surveillance footage of the incident. P.O. GALVAN then completed a license premise report.

Further follow up will need to be conducted regarding identifying the subject.

MANNAN then stated that he wanted to press charges and that the subjects' actions caused him to fear for his safety.

MANNAN was then given a community contact card and a PV-17.

I made contact with the gas station clerk, who was identified as Prabh SINGH (a/m 1/20/1999). SINGH stated there was an incident that occurred earlier with his security officer and a patron at this location. SINGH stated he did not hear what was said but could pull the video surveillance for officers to watch and download, if necessary.

SINGH was cooperative with the investigation.

Video surveillance footage was viewed and downloaded regarding and uploaded to evidence.com. Footage does need the password to view. The password is case sensitive and is (camnet123).

I watched the surveillance footage, and I observed at approximately 6:24am, the suspect vehicle, which was described as a silver Nissan Altima 4 door with tinted windows parked at pump 2 facing eastbound. I observed MANNAN exit the establishment and approach the suspect vehicle at approximately 6:28am. I observe the suspect make contact with MANNAN at approximately 6:29am and they are seen both

Upon arrival, I was met by the victim, identified as Lenerdo T GIBSON (B/M 07/10/1986) who stated that at approximately 12:26 A.M., he was shot at by an unknown suspect.

GIBSON stated he is a security guard at the gas station (1202 W HIGHLAND), and the unknown subject came inside smoking a "black and mild" Cigarillo. GIBSON stated that he cant smoke in here, and a verbal argument ensued. GIBSON stated that he removed the subject, who then stated "you fucked up". The suspect then leaves the location.

GIBSON stated he was standing in front of the window next to the entry door, when he heard several shots fired. GIBSON then looked outside and observed a bullet strike to the metal frame of the window he was standing behind.

I spoke to licensed premise employee, identified as Tariq Y WARRIACH, who stated he heard 4 gunshots at approximately 12:26 A.M. Tariq then called police. The business was *cooperative* with the investigation. The business had 1 security officer on scene. They were *unarmed*. The security guard was the victim of the incident. The security officer removed the subject prior to shots being fired.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. The footage showed the suspect and victim engage in a verbal argument before the victim shoves the suspect out of the store. The suspect from the altercation returns at 12:26 A.M, a B/M wearing a multi color hat, green jacket, and grey jeans. The suspect is seen walking e/b towards the gas station, approaches the window with a handgun in his hand, and fire several shots at the victim before fleeing w/b on w highland out of view of the camera. The video was unable to be recovered and but body camera footage of the surveillance footage was *uploaded to AXON*.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. During my investigation for RES I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise


