ORDER

This matter having come before the Court on judicial review of a decision by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee to not renew the liquor license of Club Bari, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.12, and the Court having conducted a hearing on the matter and entertained comment by counsel on the record and otherwise being fully advised on the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The matter is remanded to the City of Milwaukee License Committee for a full hearing with proper notice given to the plaintiff pursuant to the City of Milwaukee License and Permit Procedures Rule 85-3.
- 2. The Court finds that notice was not properly given by the City of Milwaukee to the last address provided by the Plaintiff.

- 3. A temporary injunction was ordered by the Court to assure that a full and complete hearing is conducted by the City of Milwaukee Licensing Committee, and then considered by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee at its July 26, 2011 meeting.
- 4. The Court will review this matter on August 1, 2011 to make sure that these requirements are complied with.
