The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/20/2018 at 12:34am Officers responded to America Sub located at 1114 W. North Avenue for a trouble with subject. The caller was the employee on scene Mohammad ANEES (W/M, 01/01/76) who reported two B/M's at the location were causing trouble. Officers located the subjects and advised them.

2. On 11/16/2019 officers were dispatched to 1114 W. North Av for a Trouble with Subject. The caller stated there was a woman smoking in the business asking for food. The business refused her service because she was smoking. The subject was gone when the officers arrived.

3. On 04/03/2024, at 1:54 AM., officers were dispatched to 1114 W. North Ave., American Sub, for a Shooting. Two male customers inside the business were approached by two male suspects. Both suspects start shooting at the two customers inside lobby of the business. Both customers escape across the street and exchange gunshots with the suspects as they flee in a vehicle. Officers did not locate any victims at the scene, but responded to local hospitals for multiple shooting victims. Employees were cooperative in the investigation and security video was obtained depicting the incident. No license violations were observed.

4. On 11/01/2024, at 2:41 AM., officers were dispatched to 1114 W. North Ave., American Sub, for a Battery complaint. A group of subjects engaged in a physical fight in the lobby of the business. None of the individuals involved wanted to be a complainant for citations. Employees were cooperative in the investigation. Security footage was observed and confirmed the incident occurred at the business.
  
5. On 02/12/2025, at 2:07 AM., officers were dispatched to 1114 W. North Ave., American Sub, for a Shooting. Officers obtained security video from the business regarding a shooting that occurred in the parking lot earlier that morning. No license violations were observed.

On April 3, 2024, I was dispatched to a shooting complaint at 1114 W North Ave (American Subs).

Prior to my arrival Multiple squads were already on scene and initiating the investigation. Squads which responded to the scene include the following:

Squad 3450 PO ZUBE and ARNOLD

Upon my arrival I blocked traffic and conducted scene security. I observed blood and casings on the sidewalk outside of the restaurant. We did not locate any victims on scene however other squads were dispatched to Mt Sinai hospital for walk-in shooting victim as well as district 5 squads which were dispatched to another location regarding a second victim of the shooting.

Due to multiple victims being shot and in different locations across the city there were multiple callers regarding this incident stating that there were shots fired inside of the location.

All employees were cooperative and gave statements to officers on scene of what they did or did not witness.

ANEES provided access to the surveillance cameras which we were able to view the shooting incident which occurred in the lobby area of the business. ANEES also voluntarily provided officers with the suspects receipt which included his credit card information to assist officers/detectives.

## CAMERA FOOTAGE SUMMARY from PO ARNOLD

1:32 AM: I observed on camera 8 WASHINGTON enters the parking lot in silver SUV which is parked in the parking lot of the store facing westbound with two black females. WASHINGTON exits the vehicle and enters the store.

1:38 AM: I observed on cameras 5/6 BURNETT enters the store.

1:39 AM: I observed on camera 8 suspect #1 enters the parking lot driving in maroon 4 door sedan with suspect #2 in the passenger seat and enters the store.

1:49 AM: I observed on camera 8 WASHINGTON exits the store and goes to the silver SUV in the parking lot

1:50 AM: I observed on camera 8 WASHINGTON leaves the silver SUV with what appears to be a bottle of liquor.

1:50 AM: I observed on cameras 5/6 WASHINGTON enters the store and walks up to BURNETT to hand him the bottle of liquor.

1:50 AM: I observed on cameras 5/6 suspect #1 starts shooting eastbound at WASHINGTON and BURNETT inside the store with the handgun inside his sweatshirt pocket.

1:50 AM: I observed on camera 1 BURNETT exits the store by crawling and runs across W North Ave. continuing southbound on N 11th St.

1:50 AM: I observed on camera 1 WASHINGTON exits the store crawling and crawls westbound on the sidewalk right outside of the store.

1:50 AM: I observed on camera 8 suspect #1 and #2 exit the store to run into the parking lot with suspect #1 pointing a handgun southbound towards North Ave. Suspect #1 then enters the maroon sedan as the driver and suspect #2 as the passenger.

1:51 AM: I observed on camera 1 the maroon sedan exits the parking lot and travels westbound on W North Ave.

1:51 AM: I observed on camera 1 WASHINGTON on the sidewalk on the southside of the store pointing a sliver handgun at the maroon sedan traveling westbound on W North Ave. I observed the gray SUV pull up to the curb next to WASHINGTON with two black females in the vehicle. I observed a black female exit the vehicle and take the handgun from WASHINGTON. I observed the two females then help WASHINGTON into the vehicle and traveling westbound on W North Ave.

On November 1, 2024, at approximately 2:41am, Squad 3331, P.O. Eduardo LOERA and I was dispatched to 1114 W. North Ave, American Subs restaurant, for a Battery.

Upon arrival I observed a black four door Nissan with no license plate in the parking lot with two females in it. I spoke to the two females who identified themselves as Lorianne L. WADE (f/b, 11/6/00) and Arnisha M. TAYLOR (f/b, 06/13/95). They stated that there had been in an altercation with another group of females. TAYLOR spoke for WADE stating that WADE had been arguing with the American Subs worker when she then got into an argument with four other females and that they 'jumped' her. I did observe some scratches on WADE's upper body.

WADE did request medical attention for an asthma attack that WADE was having. MFD responded to the scene to treat her.

P.O. LOERA spoke to the employee on duty at that time who advised him that there had been a fight between several females in the customer area of the sub shop. The employee was cooperative even pointed out one of the females involved when she walked past.

I spoke to that female who was pointed out by the employee, and she identified herself as Deasia V.

She said she was just there to get food and then suddenly she was breaking up a fight. She further stated that she was not injured.

Business owner Mohammed ANEES (m/a, 01/01/76) was also on scene and provided P.O. LOERA with video of the incident which showed the fight between the females.

There were no security guards present at this time.

We did not note the status of the licenses at this time.

None of the parties involved wished to pursue citations on the other parties and known injuries were superficial.

HALL stated that the suspect stated to her "you cut me off bitch", and HALL heard one gunshot, realized that she had been shot, and drove to mt Sinai hospital for treatment in her 2006 gold Kia Rio bearing Wi auto tag AXB7361 (vin KNADE123866179715) . HALL sustained 2 gunshot wounds to her left thigh.

## SCENE DESCRIPTION/INITIAL OBSERVATIONS:

**1114 W North Ave** – is a restaurant with the main entrance located on the Southside of the establishment exiting onto W North Ave. The parking lot to this establishment is located on the east side of the building where the incident occurred.

## LIC-PREM Inspection:

I was tasked with obtaining video footage at 1114 W. North Ave. to determine if the crime occurred at this location. I was provided access to **American Subs** security footage and observed a black SUV and a gold Kia Rio enter the parking lot of the establishment at approximately 1:24am. I observed the passenger door of the black SUV open and seconds later the SUV drives north to make a U-turn while the gold Kia parked on the east side of the parking lot. The black SUV gets onto W North Ave and travels east bound from the location. The gold Kia also makes a U-turn and follows the black SUV. This footage was obtained by CIB.

P.O. XIONG spoke to an employee who verbally identified himself as Mohammad RAFIQ (a/m 3/23/1974). See supplemental report regarding.
